BLISTERING broke sharp, vied then dueled inside around the turn, fought off inside and outside challengers through the final furlong, resolute held sway under strong handling. FRACTURE saved ground well back into the turn, quickened stride just off the rail into the lane, angled inside foes nearing the furlong marker, dug in gamely through the final sixteenth. GALLANT GROOM raced off the pace into the turn, sent to the attack three wide leaving the three eights post, fought on between rivals in upper stretch, finished willingly for the show money. GLOBETROTTING raced off the pace five wide into the turn, called up eight wide into the lane, running on the wrong lead, chased on evenly through the wire. LET'S GO LIAM sluggish out of the gate, given the queue eight deep into the lane, had no late punch. A OK tracked the vying two sum four wide around the turn, under pressure from the quarter pole, weakened through the stretch. LIL RED BEAUDETTE broke alertly, vied then dueled two wide around the turn, no match from the furlong marker, gave way to the wire. RHUMBABA scrubbed on soon after the start, never threatened.
