LUCKY FOR LIFE settled comfortably behind the runaway leader, tracked to the far turn, then launched a bid after passing the three-furlong pole, steadied slightly near the five-sixteenths marker, then slipped through on the inside into the stretch, had two rivals to the outside, kept on well under steady handling, and was just up at the wire. DOCS LEGEND was allowed to settle from the start, secured an inside position along the rail and was under some restraint racing in mid-pack, ranged up approaching the five-sixteenths marker then was the outside horse in a three-way battle down the stretch, was racing head-to-head with LUCKY FOR LIFE in the final yards, then jumped tracks about 40 feet from the wire and lost the rider after crossing the finish line. DYNAMIC VICTORY was hustled from the outside post intent on getting to the lead, went clear of the field coming out of the first turn, led the way to mid-stretch, then weakened after briefly battling between rivals. JOLLY MON raced in the middle of the pack, then lacked a finish. NATIONAL PUNCHLINE was the back marker from the start and never fired. O G MR. BRIGHTSIDE was off awkwardly, then settled near the rear with only one rival behind, angled out five-wide at the top of the stretch but did not rally. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE ACTIONS OF #1 DOCS LEGEND NEAR THE FINISH LINE., AFTER A REVIEW, IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THE HORSE JUMPED A SHADOW AND NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
