BOZAANO hustled forward after a bit of a tardy start, pressed the pace from the rail, lost some ground on the turn, then responded under a stiff drive and urging to slip through an opening along the rail into the stretch, got the first run and held clear to the wire. GAME MAKER (IRE) broke a bit awkwardly, then moved up into the pace mix, pulled even with LIFE'S ONE going into the turn, then responded when set down in the stretch, chased BOZAANO through the final stages, but could not close the gap and had to settle for second. LIFE'S ONE broke out at the start and took the path from UNION SWAG, made the early lead, dug in under threat late on the turn, battled gamely to mid-stretch, then weakened in the final yards. BITOFJUSTICE was close up three-wide through the early stages, then did not quicken with the leaders late on the turn, lost some ground, went five-wide into the stretch, was kept to task and came back on in the final furlong but too late to threaten. UNION SWAG got bumped off stride at the start from LIFE'S ONE on the inside, advanced down the backstretch and through the turn to loom four-wide at the top of the stretch, then flattened out a bit under strong handling and urging. PREDECESSOR dropped to mid-pack after a level start, raced very wide throughout, was under a ride on the turn, came about eight wide into the lane, encountered traffic at the top of the stretch, angled inside but lacked a meaningful finish. BUSTIN' BOULDERS took a bump from NOBLE SOUL at the start, raced close up but under a ride to the turn, started to lose ground and was outrun the rest of the way. NOBLE SOUL broke out and bumped the outside rival, was racing close

up behind the pace but was hard to place and steadied repeatedly in traffic before the turn, had more traffic issues through the turn, then did not respond when asked to go on once clear in the stretch. SANTORINO saved ground to no avail. SPRINGS missed the break, spotted the field a head start, and was outrun.
