POUNDS IN TOWN was reserved off the pace, rallied five-wide the final quarter and was up in the final sixteenth. SHE'S SO SEXY was unhurried early, moved p four-wide nearing the quarter pole, took the lead nearing the eighth pole but was unable to resist POUNDS IN TOWN late. CHAPTER AND VERSE prompted STYLE IN TIME from along the outside into the stretch and held on well for the show. MARMARA was prominently placed racing three-wide but lacked a rally. OUR LADY PEACE was allowed to settle, came three-wide into the stretch and went evenly late. FIVEMINUTSOFPASION was prominent early racing two-wide and weakened. STYLE IN TIME saved ground setting the early pace and tired. LIL SWEEZY gave way after showing brief speed along the inside. SHIPSHEWANA was close-up early racing along the inside but lacked a rally. MCGILL was allowed to settle while racing three-wide and failed to threaten. KATE WINS dropped back early and trailed.
