SHES A STORM stalked the leaders to the three-eighths pole, swept up four wide on the turn to take command nearing the quarter pole, quickly drew clear in upper stretch and widened convincingly down the lane. QUETZALY hustled to the lead away from the gate, set a pressured pace to just before the quarter pole, was no match for the winner but kept on willingly though the lane as second best. MY DEAR VALENTINE slow early to be well off the leaders at the rear of the field, commenced a steady, long drive on the turn and finished with a late gain along the inside to be up for the show. JUSTWORTHASHOT pressed the pace to the five-sixteenths pole and lacked a response when called upon. SUPER SCAMP went evenly never posing a threat. BOLD ZEE dropped out as a non-factor.

PENNY'S TREASURE hopped at the start giving the field several lengths from the gate, made a steady rally along the inside through the turn, cutting the corner to engage the leaders at the head of the stretch, drew away through the lane and was well in hand late in an impressive performance. MOST ADORABLE stalked the pacesetter to the quarter pole, rallied five wide turning for home, was no match for the winner but finished well to be second best. DEE'S KY WILDCAT reserved off the leaders through the turn, angled wide to the clear and mounted a belated bid to gain the show. WINDY VALLEY set the pace on a clear lead to the quarter pole, had no answer when challenged at the top of the lane and weakened coming home. SOMETHING LUCKY prompted the early pace down the backside, had no response when called upon on the turn and steadily faded in the stretch. WELLOILED CAT trailed throughout and was never a threat.

STRIKE APPEAL reserved off the pace early while racing wide in the clear down the backside, angled in saving ground on the far turn, angled four wide around the tiring pacesetters splitting horses to engage the leaders in mid-stretch and finished in a drive to prevail in the final hundred yards. ICE BLAST tracked the leaders down the backstretch from wide in the clear, rallied at the five-sixteenths pole six wide to challenge for the lead midway down the lane and finished well as second best. MAMBA FOREVER pressed the pace in a duel for three-quarters, took command briefly turning for home, dug-in when engaged in upper stretch and weakened late in the drive in a game effort. HAD RIGHT raced mid-pack evenly without impact. BOSS BEAR trailed most of the way and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. KLAATU raced in early contention down the backside and steadily faded entering the final turn. HARD ASTRAY dueled from the inside to the quarter pole and gave way. PARTY OF NO chased the pace from five wide for five-eighths and tired.

EXALTED JOY reserved off the pace for the first five-eighths, made a steady rally circling six wide and closed well on the outside to reel in the leader inside the final fifty yards and be going away at the wire. SEE SPOT RUN tracked the leaders for the first half mile, mounted a bid on the far turn to take the lead at the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage in the stretch and was caught late in the drive in a good effort. CORONA GRANDE rated off the pace near the rear of the field through the final turn and showed some late interest with a mild bid to gain the show. THE RED MAN set the pace on a clear lead through the first turn, held the lead down the backside under constant pressure, dug-in when passed on the turn and kept-on through the lane willingly. A NEW PEACE set a well rated pace on a clear, comfortable lead, repelled the challenge of the runner up turning for home and held that one safe the length of the lane. LUBU stalked the winner the entire way, made a bid nearing the quarter pole, failed to pass the winner and kept-on willingly as second best. SACRED CONNECTION reserved off the pace for the first five-eighths, made a steady gain on the turn, split rivals in upper stretch from four wide and closed well belatedly as best of the rest. CHESS NOT CHECKERS tracked the leaders through the far turn in striking position, angled to the inside cutting the corner turning for home to loom in upper stretch and failed to sustain the bid finishing evenly. ELIKA raced wide into the first turn, continued to chase from wide throughout and failed to menace at any time. TIMELY SECRET was well palce while racing five wide down the backside and lacked a response when called upon at the top of the lane. SWEET SERENADE trailed early and was never a threat. SHEWEARSMYRING raced mid-pack to the backside, dropped to the rear of the field nearing the half mile pole and was not a factor.
