FORT GRANDE bumped leaving the gate from the outside, raced up to stalk the pacesetters through the turn and lacked aclosing kick in the drive. SEEKING FREEDOM went evenly failing to menace. WEEKEND RETREAT was the distant trailer early and never proved to be a factor.
