COWBOY LUKE bumped by outside rival away from the gate, moved up to press the pace from three wide to the top of the stretch, lost ground to the pacesetter in upper stretch, dug-in determinedly to battle head and head to the wire and prevailed in the final stride. BREEZE THE BAYOU set a pressured pace dueling with the winner to the quarter pole, kicked away in upper stretch and battled gamely to the wire only to lose the bob on the line. TWICE SHY chased the top pair through the turn and down the lane, was unable to gain on them but kept-on willingly to hold the show. THISISRIDICULOUS reserved off the pace through the turn, circled six wide at the head of the lane and made a mild bid while grinding down the lane. DIXIE MAN tracked the leaders from the inside and rallied mildly in the lane without impact. DASH TO FINISH trailed most of the way never posing a threat. SAVE FERRIS broke inward bumping the winner leaving the gate, hustled into early contention, lacked a response when called upon in the turn and faded to the rear of the field.

WHO CAN'T WAIT broke alertly to quickly sprint clear of the field, widened the advantage down the backstretch, took a needed breather on the far turn, repelled the mild challenge of the runner-up midway down the lane and kicked away to the wire unthreatened. HIDDEN HEART raced very wide on the first turn, settled to a tracking position down the backside, commenced a steady rally midway on the final bend to narrow the winner's advantage in mid-stretch and flattened out late unable to sustain the bid. DUDE THE LEGEND broke wide to be a step slow from the gates, was unhurried for the first five-eighths and made a belated stretch rally with late interest. FORMYBOYS chased the run-off leader for five-eighths into the far turn and lacked a response when called upon on the bend. INDY'S HOPE reserved off the pace for the first half mile, gained ground into the far turn, was put to an early drive and went evenly unable to mount a kick. WANDALOU'S PRIDE stalked the pace for the first half mile and faded on the final turn. EVANS WORLD was never involved.

COWTOWN BOSS took control quickly from the gate, opened a clear, well measured advantage to the head of the lane and kicked away in the stretch unchallenged. VICTORY DIVISION unhurried in the early going to trail to midway on the turn, rallied along the inside cutting the corner turning for home and closed best of the rest to gain the place. WEEKEND BUZZ reserved off the pace along the inside through the turn, drifted out several paths at the top of the lane and mounted a mild stretch rally. POWERFUL PHIL prompted the pace through the turn, could not gain on the winner and weakened down the lane. WHAT A RUSH hustled in the first quarter mile to gain a stalking position down the backside from between rivals, chased the leader through the turn under a hard drive and flattened out in the stretch. SHOW SLIDING HOME made an early bid on the backstretch following suit from five wide with WHAT A RUSH and came up empty on the turn. PLAY BALL was never a factor.

SO THAT'S THAT took the lead from the gates, was kept in hand surrendering the lead to early presser down the backside, re-claimed the top spot into the turn opening a clear lead at the quarter pole and finished willingly holding the closers safe late. GUESS AGAIN reserved off the pace near the rear of the main body, rallied along the inside cutting the corner turning for home and finished well up the inside to garner the palce. STRIKE PLATE tracked the leader through the turn, angled seven wide while mounting a steady rally and just missed the place. CARSON N SPENCE broke inward leaving the gate, straightened away quickly to get into stride pulling to the lead, battled with the winner on the turn, could not go with that one approaching the quarter pole and kept-on through the lane being outkicked late in the drive for the minor awards. FORT GRANDE bumped leaving the gate from the outside, raced up to stalk the pacesetters through the turn and lacked aclosing kick in the drive. SEEKING FREEDOM went evenly failing to menace.
