BLAZING TONY was hard to load prior to the start, showed speed four deep into the first turn then raced keenly outside inner pair around the bend, continued to pull a bit on the backstretch, challenged in the three path around the far turn, took over at the quarter pole, carried a short lead into the final furlong, then put away VECCHI midstretch and won going away. VECCHI vied between runners for a bit then dueled from outside, took control on the backstretch, challenged by BLAZING TONY on the far turn, relinquished the lead with a quarter mile remaining, fought inside that rival to the eighth pole, could not keep up in midstretch and managed to save second. KENNEDY'S CAMELOT showed brief speed three deep between rivals into the first turn, dropped back and shifted to the two path around the bend, remained two wide around the far turn, tipped out leaving the bend, kept trying down the lane and missed second. ATLAS FALLS raced three wide at the back early, picked up stride on the backstretch, put in a mild bid three deep in the four path on the far turn, could not sustain the challenge late on the bend, kept on down the lane and missed the place and show. WHY KENNY WHY tucked inside off the pace, closed in on the backstretch, saved ground around the far turn, drifted into the lane and came up empty. JAC'S EMPIRE dueled from inside to the backstretch, dropped back in the middle stages, pulled up on the far turn and walked off.
