FOURDATESFORHOCO hustled up into the early pace mix, settled just behind LIVE A LITTLE, pushed ahead approaching the three-furlong pole but found a resurgent foe, gained the advantage in upper stretch, then held clear under steady handling to the wire. THIS TIME raced close up along the rail, tipped out to the three path for the stretch run, and chased FOURDATESFORHOCO gamely through the stretch. TEMPERED DREAM always close up three-wide, bid five-wide into the stretch, and finished up well to gain third. KNOCK WOOD settled back, moved closer heading into the turn, loomed three-wide through the turn, did not change leads in upper stretch, and flattened out. ELECTRIC MELODY chased at the back of the main pack but never far from the front, went six-wide into the stretch, finished well, but was unable to threaten. LIVE A LITTLE was sent to the front from the break, battled back under a threat at the three-furlong pole, then gave way in mid-stretch. WASABI BEACH stumbled badly at the start, spotted the field a massive head start, and was galloped out to the wire along the rail. THERE WAS A STEWARDS REVIEW OF THE START. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
