INDIAN FEVER showed good early foot from inside, fought with outer pair then cleared at the halfway point, showed the way through the far turn, met the bid from GOLD BUCKLE at the top of the stretch and turned that rival away in the late stages. GOLD BUCKLE raced up close four deep, was closest in pursuit three then two wide on the second bend, challenged INDIAN FEVER from outside at the top of the stretch and got turned away in the furlong grounds. WHY NOT ME broke out and brushed BROADWAY SKY, chased three then two wide around the first turn, angled to the inside and was coaxed along on the backstretch, got put in a bit tight past the seven-sixteenths pole, angled out and came five wide into the lane, put in a late run and earned the show honors. BROADWAY SKY got brushed from inside leaving the gate, tracked in the four path around the clubhouse turn, remained through the second bend, came three wide into the stretch and flattened out. AGNELLO'S DREAM got bumped from inside in the beginning, trailed in the two path around the first turn, raced inside a rival through the second bend still at the rear, offered a mild response when called upon and earned a minor award. NOT YET CHARLIE stalked three wide for a bit then went up to fight for the lead three deep, lost touch with the leader at the half-mile pole, chased in the three path on the far turn then got carried six wide by WHY NOT ME and weakened in the stretch. WILL E SUTTON bumped outer rival at the start, stalked from inside, dropped back in the middle stages, trailed outside a rival around the far turn and had little left for the drive. FOREVER LASTING vied from outside then between rivals to the backstretch, failed to keep up with the leader at the half-mile pole, chased two wide through the second bend and tired.
