ABUNDANT ENERGY broke in and bumped, moved into range, chased two wide then along the rail late on the turn, challenged the leader from the fence turning for home, put a head in front at the sixteenth pole and held over the runner-up. LET'S GO LIAM chased three wide into the turn, moved out to the four path came back in to exit the bend three wide, put in a late bid three deep and got up for second. NASTINATE sprinted clear, showed the way two to three wide around the bend, met the bid from ABUNDANT ENERGY coming into the lane, resisted to the sixteenth pole, then yielded to the top pair late. AXCEL tracked off the rail up the backstretch, went three wide into the turn, got floated to the five path then returned to the three path and flattened out in the stretch. RHUMBABA got bumped repeatedly by A OK at the start, chased along the inside into the turn, moved to the two path around the bend, angled out into the stretch and lacked a rally. A OK got bumped around on both sides leaving the gate, raced up close on the inside, lost ground on the turn and tired in the lane. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING RHUMBABA, A OK AND ABUNDANT ENERGY AT THE START AND RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.
