BITOFJUSTICE chased from inside, put in a rail bid and fought with outer rivals around the bend, battled to midstretch and drove clear in the last sixteenth. UNION SWAG tracked from inside then outside a rival, challenged between foes on the turn and put a head in front, drifted out and bumped NOBLE SOUL in upper stretch, relinquished the lead midstretch and held second. NOBLE SOUL had good early foot to take the lead, raced two wide into the turn, drifted out a bit to allow a pair of rivals to challenge and lost command, fought three deep to the lane, got bumped by UNION SWAG in upper stretch and flattened out in the late stages. TROUBLE OR NOTHIN stalked the speed three deep, took an awkward step behind a rival at the seven-sixteenths pole, chased five wide into the lane and kept trying for a minor award. THUNDER SURPRISE broke awkwardly for a slow start, rushed up to challenge the leader from outside, could not keep up four wide around the bend and tired in the lane. AQUARIAN PRINCE was off slow in the beginning, trailed up the backstretch, rounded the bend three then two wide and was never a factor.
