PRINCESS HALIME settled in behind MALICED through the early stages, ramped up the pressure going into the turn, took the lead after passing the three-furlong pole with TIZ INDEPENDENCE a presence to the outside, shook off that foe in mid-stretch, and surged clear to the finish in the late stages. TIZ INDEPENDENCE settled three-wide off the early pace, ranged up near the half, pressed PRINCESS HALIME through the far turn, loomed a threat in upper stretch but could not kick on with that one late and had to settle for second. WICCA WISDOM raced between horses in the tracking group, took aim in the stretch, but lacked the needed late kick. MALICED was sent hard to secure the early advantage, then gave way with three furlongs to run. BEAUTIFUL MANDATE raced wide throughout and lacked a finish. ROUBAIX trailed while in range up the backstretch, lost ground, and failed to menace.
