BREEZY MONEY vied for the lead around the first turn, took command from the two path entering the backstretch, was ridden into the far turn, faced a pair of outer challenges rounding the far turn, but dug in at the top of the lane, and drew away in the final furlong. MASTER OF THE NITE stalked the pace, bumped with an inner foe midway up the backstretch, bid under coaxing from the four path early around the far turn, could not keep up with the winner down the stretch, but finished evenly on the left lead for place. WASHINGTON'S UNION showed the way around the first turn then was taken back to lay up close just behind the pacesetter up the backstretch, exchanged bumps with an outer foe midway up the backstretch, bid between foes in the three path passing the three-eighths pole, fought on to sustain that bid in upper stretch, but flattened in the final furlong for show. SOLOMONS GOLD tracked inside up the backstretch but weakened. SKY KEY raced off the pace outside of foes but retreated. DIGITAL FOOTPRINT trailed throughout. NO CHANGES WERE MADE AFTER THE STEWARDS HELD AN INQUIRY TO LOOK AT THE RUN AROUND THE FIVE-EIGHTHS POLE.
