NORTHSIDE TAP raced in the middle of the pack down the backstretch then moved up from the four path on the final turn and took the lead near the top of the stretch while fighting gamely for the win. LOOKIN LIKE LUCKY tracked the leaders from the two path down the backstretch then saved ground on the final turn and made a rail bid in the stretch to be second best. BRIARCLIFF rushed away to take the lead midway through the first turn then drew clear to near the quarter pole but was eclipsed near the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. MARAVICH chased the leaders down the backstretch then moved up from the two path on the final turn to make a late run and improved his position. LORD BARANOF broke sharply to take the lead to the first turn while racing in the five path into the first turn then stalked the pace to midway down the backstretch before making a middle move and flattening out. KEI trailed the field to the top of the stretch then passed a tired on but was not a threat. LAO WAY cut the corner into the first turn to take a brief early lead then settled off the pace to midway down the backstretch before retreating and outrun.
