JASPER MAXIMUS sped away from the gate to set an unchallenged pace before drawing off in upper stretch to prove best in her debut. WEELASSIE settled in the middle of the pack while racing two wide then tipped out to three wide near the quarter pole to make the late run to be second best. ELECTRIC EDEN raced off the pace from four wide in the second flight before edging away from that group going into the turn but was no match for the winner and was outfinished late. DOLLAR DANCE chased the leaders from four or five wide while moving up around the turn but flattened out. SEYVAL BLANC raced off the pace in the second flight from two wide to the top of the stretch but lacked a response and was best of the rest. HONOR QUEST raced near the back to the top of the stretch before making a belated bid to improve her position. BEACHGLASS raced in the middle of the pack while racing three wide, advanced from two wide to midway through the turn and had no impact while giving an even effort. IMPOSTORA raced near or at the back while saving ground, made a mild bid on the turn but was not a threat. INSTANT WINNER raced off the pace in the second flight from the inside to the turn then slowly faded and was not a factor. PYRAMID SCHEME was always back and outrun. RAVISHING RUBY unsettled in the gate prior to the start then raced off the pace from three wide in the second flight to the turn then retreated and was done.
