HOOF AND BOOTS was pinched at the start, raced near the rear and five-wide down the backstretch, continued three-wide into the turn, came under some urging at that point, swung out to the five or six path into the stretch, and finished up well to win by a comfortable margin. HONOR AND OBAY broke out at the start, but was still away best, ceded the front to TALE OF LEMONBELLE, then was let loose and cleared away from the rest, leaving the three-furlong pole, was clear in mid-stretch but on the wrong lead and shortening strides, and gave way late to the winner while still well clear of the next horse. STRIKING LADY broke in a tangle, settled mid-pack, then kept on late to take the minor award. JEN D'ORO lost the path after the start and changed path to the inside, started a forward move going into the turn, lacked a clear path, backed off, then was kept to task through the stretch and managed to improve position. THIS ONE'S FOR US veered out at the start, raced wide throughout and lacked a finish. TALE OF LEMONBELLE rushed up to take the early lead, then gave way readily early on the turn. R CANDY ducked in at the start, making some contact with HOOF AND BOOTS, raced near the back and four-wide throughout.
