ONIRICO broke last but rushed up to seize the early lead, had one rival in close attendance on the turn, then cleared off when asked to go, leaving the quarter pole and widening the margin through the stretch. GONE WILD pressed ONIRICO two-wide through the early stages, was no match for that rival from the quarter pole, but kept on well to hold second, well clear of the rest. MR. BALI raced well off the pace, came under a stiff drive from the three-furlong pole, finished with some interest, dove to the rail for the final furlong and moved up to take the minor award. DOCS LEGEND broke in a tangle, then was the inside horse in the tracking trio, was outkicked in the final stages, but kept on with an even finish. KICKSTART broke out at the start and was last early, raced three to four wide throughout, failed to change leads in the stretch, and never threatened. LITTLE SHANCE dropped back after a good start, chased three-wide in the second flight, was in range approaching the quarter pole, then flattened out in the stretch. MAGIC MOTOWN got bumped by the inside rival at the start, raced in the middle of the pack to the half-mile pole, then steadily retreated from that point.
