COWGIRLS HUMOR stumbled at the break then veered out awkwardly, bothering WILD MARIAH, was then hustled to the lead ahead of a rival pressing the issue to the outside, maintained a clear margin through the turn while under a drive, left the rail open for WILD MARIAH to slip through and challenge for the lead into the stretch, drifted in under right-handed urging putting the rival in-tight just inside the sixteenth, then went clear in the final yards. WILD MARIAH lost the path after the start, steadied, then was allowed to settle into stride, advanced to be close up to the front past the half-mile pole, slipped through an opening along the rail to bid for the lead in upper stretch, got put in tight and steadied again inside the sixteenth marker, and was unable to regain momentum. MANDATED EVENT stalked COWGIRLS HUMOR from the start, had to be hard-ridden to keep up from the three-furlong pole, then flattened out in the stretch but managed to save third. PRINCESS EM tracked at the back of the main pack, not far from the front, was in a full-out drive going into the turn, and went evenly through the late stages while never posing a serious threat. EMERALD EYES tracked three-wide down the backstretch, made a mild move through the turn, swung five-wide into the stretch but was unable to sustain the bid and faltered in the stretch. IAMGOINGTOMAKEIT bore out after the start, never really got running, dropped far behind the field, was eased up late on the turn, walked out to the finish line well behind the rest and was walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN, AND ALSO THE JOCKEY ON #3 WILD MARIAH LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST #2 COWGIRLS HUMOR ALLEGING INTEREFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH. AFTER A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UPHELD THE CLAIM OF FOUL AND DISQUALIFIED #2 COWGIRLS HUMOR FROM THE WIN AND PLACED 2ND.

RUN PANCITA broke well then backed out of the developing pace battle, dropped to the rail before the turn, then moved up, waited for room through the turn, got a huge hole to run through, finished well up the rail to outduel a stubborn TAP THE WIND and prevail in a tight finish. TAP THE WIND was the inside horse in the early pace scramble, went on to duel with BUCKEYE MIKE through the turn, got a narrow advantage approaching the quarter pole, then came into the stretch with a narrow lead between horses in upper stretch, dueled with RUN PANCITA through the last furlong but came up short in the end. BUCKEYE MIKE broke out at the start, making contact with PLAYFULASITGETS, vied vied between horses in the early pace battle, kept the pressure on TAP THE WIND through the turn, loomed a threat in upper stretch, but could not go with the top pair in the late stages, but finished a mile clear of the next horse. GRAY TORMENTOR chased the pace close up four-wide under a ride down the backstretch, bid five-wide into the stretch, and produced a steady finish but was still well behind the top three. ATLAS FALLS was very slow into stride, dropped far behind the field early, then rallied past tiring foes in the stretch, but never posed a serious threat. 

DR SCHUSTER veered out at the start, then got caught four-wide on the first turn, pulled five-wide to be up close to the leader approaching the halfway point, continued to advance through the far turn, then bid three-wide for the lead near the quarter pole, gained command in upper stretch, drew clear under steady handling, and held off a late challenge to prevail. LAW OF THE JUNGLE got pinched at the start, settled inside through the first turn, appeared full of run going into the far turn but lacked a clear path, swept around the field on the last bend, then finished up strong but lugged in through the stretch and came up short in the end. FULL SPECTRUM got away well and was always prominent, tracked close up four-wide down the backstretch under light restraint, then was let loose with three furlongs to run, bid between horses at the quarter pole, could not find another gear when needed in the stretch, and was outfinished. LOMACHENKO hustled from the break and won the race into the first turn, led the way down the backstretch while left to dictate the fractions, surrendered the lead at the quarter pole, kept on well to mid-stretch, then weakened. BRIGHTER DAY hopped in the air at the start, raced three-to-four wide throughout, made a mild late bid but lacked a late kick. RAMSEY was bumped by the inside rival at the start, settled in the middle of the pack, towards the rear, then advanced under a ride through the far turn, but went a little flat in the stretch and was unable to give the needed response. SHAKE THE FROST broke out at the start and into the path of LAW OF THE JUNGLE, was pushed to get a forward position, then settled into a stalking position to the outside of LOMACHENKO down the backstretch, was surrounded and overtaken near the seven-sixteenths marker, faded to the back and had little left to give in the stretch. SWING STATE saved ground racing close up to the far turn, started to lose ground near the three-furlong pole, and was uninvolved in the late stages. SIGHT UNSEEN got pinballed at the start, took up, and was last into the first turn, was content to trail to the far turn, made a six-wide bid late on the far turn but faltered in upper stretch and could not threaten.

JEMEL broke on top but ceded the early lead, dropped back to mid-pack on the backstretch run, then launched a bid with three furlongs to go, tipped out to the three path for the stretch run and finished best to run down ILLUMINATE in the final yards. ILLUMINATE broke well, dueled inside a rival to the far turn, surrendered the lead near the quarter pole, but kept on under strong handling, came back to reclaim the lead in mid-stretch, was clear inside the sixteenth but could not hold off the winner in the final yards. EXALTADA ducked in at the start and spotted the field a head start, regained contact late on the backstretch run, put in a good finish under a drive and just got up to gain the minor award. HOLIDAYS ARMY BRAT broke well, dueled ILLUMINATE through the early stages, poked a head in front approaching the quarter pole, had a short lead in upper stretch, but weakened in the last furlong. ROLLIN FREEDOM tracked just behind the dueling leaders, bid three-wide at the top of the stretch, failed to change leads, and faltered. SMALL TOWN GOSSIP was always wide and flattened out in the stretch. LESOTHO took up at the start, was always near the back, and did not threaten. J. P INDY chased throughout and was never a factor.
