SKYTREE brushed with MACHICO MADEIRA at the start, was up with the early leaders but under some coaxing from the rider to keep pace, swung four-wide into the lane, idled a bit in upper stretch, then found best stride in the final furlong, and surged clear in the final yards. UNBRIDLED O'BRIEN vied inside early, settled just behind MACHICO MADEIRA through the turn, bid up the rail in the stretch, hit the front inside the furlong pole but was outkicked by the winner. MR. RIFFLE broke inward but was otherwise away well, was always close up, loomed a threat coming off the last bend, but flattened out a bit in deep stretch. LEAVETHENINETYNINE outpaced in the early stages, tracked four-wide down the backstretch, then was mildly gaining late while racing mostly on the wrong lead through the stretch. JOLLY MON hustled up after the start, then settled at the rear of the main pack going into the turn, lost ground on the leaders on the turn, was kept to task late, and finished up with some energy but was never a serious threat. MACHICO MADEIRA took a light bump from SKYTREE then veered in after the start, showed good speed to take the early lead, opened up a bit midway through the turn, had the lead at the head of the lane but weakened in the final furlong. WISLEY lost the path and steadied at the start, chased five-wide under a drive, then weakened before the stretch. BUKELE was off slow and came out of the gate a bit awkwardly, raced in the middle of the field in the second flight down the backstretch, made a mild three-wide move into the turn, went about seven-wide at the top of the stretch, but was unable to rally. EMBERLIGHT tracked three-wide near the rear and lacked a finish. DREAM POLICE raced close up early, then backed off before the three-furlong pole and was uninvolved in the late stages. IT'S LAST CALL raced in mid-pack, started to run on with three furlongs to go, finished well, was never getting to the winner, and finished far clear of the third horse. LAKETOWN ELLY had good speed from the break and seized a clear lead with the rider trying to temper the pace, was coaxed along a bit through the turn to maintain the margin, and responded when set down in the stretch to hold clear. CRACK A SMILE lost the path and took up at the break, went to the rail, advanced inside through the turn under ride, found best stride in deep stretch, and gained the place. COWGIRLTAKEMEAWAY was impeded at the start but also slow to begin, made a steady advance from the back of the pack, went five-wide into the stretch, and ran on under strong handling and urging to get up for third. RON DAH LOU was allowed to settle into stride after the break, then made an aggressive forward move from the half-mile pole to make a run at LAKETOWN ELLY loose on the lead, loomed a mild threat approaching the stretch, but had trouble keeping a straight course and faltered. WATCH ME DADDY veered across several paths at the start, bumped with MON MINOU, was under a ride into the turn, and made a mild bid approaching the stretch but could not sustain and was uninvolved in the late stages. GABADOST hopped in the air at the start, spotting the field a head start, trailed to the turn, ran past a couple of tiring rivals in the stretch. GREEK BOUTIQUE broke in a tangle, then tracked mid-pack down the backstretch, came under pressure approaching the quarter pole, then tired in the stretch. MON MINOU got bumped at the start, then chased LAKETOWN ELLY to the turn, weakened leaving the three-furlong pole, and had nothing to offer in the stretch.

COUPLE BEERS DEEP got squeezed a bit at the start, then rushed to the lead, with a couple of rivals pressing the issue not far back, maintained a length or two through the turn, then responded when set down approaching the stretch and widened in the final yards. WILD DOMAIN was outrun initially but moved up late on the backstretch run to join the early leaders, came four-wide at the top of the stretch, had come trouble changing leads but finished up best of the rest to be a clear second. TRUTH N SOUL veered in at the start, settled mid-pack wide down the backstretch, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole, dove to the inside in upper stretch, was outkicked but moved late into third. RICH ON THE RIVER stumbled exiting the gate, pulled hard to press the early pace, made a bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, angled to the rail in upper stretch, flattened, and was outfinished for a minor award. RIVERS RUN FAST broke in at the start and bumped hard with LUCKY JUULZ, was near the back through the early stages, then steadily moved up through the turn, went a little flat in the stretch had trouble keeping a straight course in the late stages. BIG DADDY HANK stumbled at the start, then rushed up inside to join the leaders, struggled to keep up through the turn, and had little to offer in the stretch. LUCKY JUULZ was off-balance exiting the gate, took a hard bump from RIVERS RUN FAST, settled at the back of the field while also racing wide and did not threaten. MY FOR O ONE KAY was away a bit awkwardly, steadied early, and was never involved. CATCHING MY WIND was briefly close to the half, then steadily retreated to the back. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
