OUR LADY PEACE settled just off the pace but was being coaxed along some to keep pace, launched a bid approaching the three-furlong pole border bid three-wide for the lead passing the quarter pole, took a slight lead in upper stretch with GEEGEE'S STORY in pursuit, then drifted in under right-handed urging, and put that rival in tight just past the furlong pole, and went clear to the wire. GEEGEE'S STORY settled in a stalking position behind AZTEC MELODY down the backstretch, then moved up to put pressure on that one on the turn, put that rival away by the head of the stretch, then dueled with OUR LADY PEACE down the stretch, then took up when that rival took the path just inside the furlong marker and could not recover. POWER PARTY void of speed from the start, was a distant trailer to the stretch, then put in a strong late rally to get up for third. SHE HAD A SECRET settled at the rear with POWER PARTY, rallied late alongside that rival and just missed a minor award. AZTEC MELODY was quickest from the gate and cleared early, got some pressure from GEEGEE'S STORY through the turn but battled back before tiring in the stretch. ENDLESS FASHION raced a couple of lengths off the pace along the rail through the early running, then lacked a finishing kick.

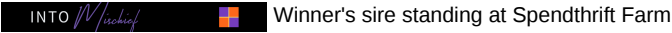

THANKS FRANK was sent from the break and cleared the field, got pressed by TONIGHT from the start, came three-wide into the stretch but held that one and several others at bay through the stretch to prevail in a gritty effort. GAMBOLING GHOST moved up after a tardy start, was sent forward four-wide from the half-mile pole to go after the leaders, and was having to be hard-ridden to keep up late on the turn, dropped down to the two path for the stretch run, and finished well, could not get to the winner but won the battle for the place. TONIGHT got bumped by AURA OF GOLD at the start and rebounded into FINISTERE, pressed the early pace while under a hard hold to the turn, chased close up through the turn and into the stretch, gave a good effort but was outfinished. ROUNDBALL ROCK hustled from the break, pressed the pace three-wide early, bid under a hard ride from the three-furlong pole, came four-wide into the stretch, finished well under strong handling and urging, but could not find the extra gear when needed in the final furlong. AURA OF GOLD took a bump from THANKS FRANK at the start and was in turn forced into TONIGHT, tracked between horses in the second flight, made a forward move into the turn but became briefly boxed in, angled to the rail and finished with interest but was not quite good enough in the late stages. FINISTERE took a bump after the start, then pushed to press the early pace, started to lose ground on the leaders as they passed the three-furlong pole, had some trouble changing leads in the upper stretch, but managed to close a bit late under strong handling. VERBIER was close in the initial stage after a level start, dropped off the pace heading into the turn, and never threatened. COWBOY JUSTICE was off a step slow and always behind.

SEEKING FREEDOM brushed with HARSH TRUTH at the break but rushed up inside to stalk the early pace, bided time through the turn, then angled out to about four-wide but into the path of MAN'S CHOICE, forcing that one to take up, finished well under strong handling and urging to get up in the last jump. NATIONAL STORY broke well, pressed the pace three-wide early, pulled even with three furlongs to run, battled a stubborn REDDEN through the stretch, put a head in front just past the eighth pole, and just failed to last. VECCHI ducked in at the start, bothering the two rivals in adjacent stalls, raced close up at the back of the forward group, bid five-wide at the top of the stretch, steadied to avoid contact with MAN'S CHOICE, then came back on under steady handling to just miss. DOUBLE AGENT got bumped hard by VECCHI at the start, rebounded into the inside rival and took up, chased well off the pace, then put in a strong run through the stretch but came up a bit short. MAN'S CHOICE was a little slow to get going but found a good rhythm after a furlong, tracked close up four-wide, loomed five-wide turning into the stretch, then took up when SEEKING FREEDOM took the path, angled to the inside, and finished up well but was stuck behind horses and took up in traffic in the final yards. REDDEN broke best, made the early running and led the field through the turn, dug in under threat near the quarter pole, battled gamely through the stretch, but gave way in the final yards. SMOOCHER shied from contact after the break, moved to the inside, then took up just past the eleven-sixteenths marker, was sent up three-wide to try and regain contact with the field, improved a bit, but was unable to sustain the bid beyond the quarter pole. HARSH TRUTH broke well but was outpaced from the start, was far behind to the stretch, but was

kept to task late, and managed to beat one to the wire. VERNON'S BEST was slow to begin, then took up when bumped by DOUBLE AGENT, moved up and down the backstretch to get to midfield by the turn, then weakened under a drive and had nothing to offer late. THE JOCKEYS ON #9 MAN'S CHOICE AND #7 VECCHI LODGED OBJECTIONS AGAINST #1 SEEKING FREEDOM, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH. AFTER A REVIEW, BOTH OBJECTIONS WERE UPHELD, AND #1 SEEKING FREEDOM WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED 5TH.

CURIOUS CORN angled inside after the break, tracked three-wide into the turn, hooked into a duel with SHADOW STRIKE in the stretch, drifted out, exchanged bumps in the final yards, and just lasted. SHADOW STRIKE lost the path and took up after the break, rushed up into the early pace mix a bit aggressively and had to steady near the nine-sixteenths marker, tipped out into the clear midway through the turn, had aim on the leading pair at the top of the stretch, hooked into a duel with CURIOUS CORN in deep stretch, was getting leaned on late and just missed. PROFESSOR NICK stumbled at the start and broke outward into SHADOW STRIKE, gathered up at the back of the pack, then began a steady advance from the half-mile pole, picked off rivals racing three-wide through the turn, then finished well to gain third well behind the top pair. AFTER SUNRISE got shuffled back after the start, was under a ride to regain contact with the field, circled five-wide on the turn, then finished up well but on the wrong lead through the stretch. STRIKE PLATE sent hard from the break, dueled with GRITS N GRAVY early, then went off to a solo lead through the turn, fought back when confronted by CURIOUS CORN, battled to mid-stretch, then gave way. HALEY'S DANTE tracked five-wide from the middle of the field, kept on under drive through the late stages, but lacked the needed response. HE IS DYNAMIC was briefly up with the pace battle, then dropped back to last before the turn, came three-wide into the stretch and outfinished some tiring foes. GRITS N GRAVY broke outward, bumped MOMENT IN THE DARK and steadied after the break, then rushed up to join the early pace battle, struggled to keep pace late on the turn, and had little to offer in the stretch. LUCKY'S PRIZE chased between horses in the second flight, then staged a steady retreat through the turn and was uninvolved in the later stages. MOMENT IN THE DARK raced in mid-pack on the inside to the stretch,

then came up empty. THERE WAS A STEWARD INQUIRY INTO THE START AND STRETCH RUN, AND THE JOCKEY ON #4 SHADOW STRIKE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST #11 CURIOUS CORN ALLEGING INTERFERENCE NEAR THE FINISH. AFTER A REVIEW THE OBJECTION WAS UPHELD AND #11 CURIOUS CORN WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM THE WIN AND PLACED SECOND.

CROWN THE BUCKEYE broke inward and mutually bumped with GLOBAL EVENT at the start, went five-wide into the first turn, then moved up towards the front on the backstretch run, bid for the lead approaching the three-furlong pole, met some resistance but took command in upper stretch and held clear to the finish. WATER INTO WINE was first into the clubhouse turn, went a length clear turning onto the backstretch, responded when challenged by CROWN THE BUCKEYE approaching the three-furlong pole, but could not go on with that one late, but kept trying and finished a mile clear of the next horse. GLOBAL EVENT broke out and bumped with CROWN THE BUCKEYE at the start, settled four-wide close up after a clean break, became boxed in late on the backstretch run, tipped out four-wide into the clear late on the far turn, lugged in through upper stretch, then managed to outfinish MARK MY WORDS for the third spot. PRAISE N GLORY came away from the gate in good order and took up a staking position just to the outside of MINESTRESS, was content to hold position down the backstretch, then was sent along approaching the three-furlong pole as the pace picked up, loomed three-wide at the top of the stretch, was idling in upper stretch then responded to right handed urging in the last furlong, and edged ahead in the final yards. MINESTRESS had good speed from the break with the rider taking a firm hold, slowed the pace to a crawl through the first tun, then ceded the front to MY GIRL KEW heading down the backstretch, was still being held up approaching the far turn, then let loose near the seven-sixteenths marker, was stuck behind horses late on the far turn, tipped out to the three path in the stretch for clear run, finished up well but got headed at the wire. CANDLELIGHT HOURS got caught three wide on the first turn, tracked close up four-wide to the far turn, moved up to second heading into the turn, got a head in front turning for home, but was outfinished in the final yards. HERE'S THE SPIDER away a bit awkwardly then taken back after the start, moved over to the rail, rated at the back of the pack, advanced down the backstretch to be up close as the field went into the far turn, then was stuck behind horses in the stretch but unable to quicken once clear. COUNTESS COLETTE got bumped by MY GIRL KEW at the start, settled in mid-pack through the early stages, bid five-wide into the lane but was outkicked. SHE'S CRAFTY unhurried from the start, went three-wide into the first turn, settled at the rear through the first half, started a forward move approaching the three-furlong pole but was outsprinted in the late stages. MY GIRL KEW broke in and bumped COUNTESS COLETTE, then got put in tight before passing the finish line the first time, checked hard, nearly clipping heels, pulled forward to gain the lead coming out of the clubhouse turn, went a little over a length clear, kept the lead as the pace quickened into the far turn, fought back against a host of challengers in the stretch, then gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. GREEN LADY veered out at the start, then went three wide through the first turn, settled near the back, then dropped off the pace approaching the three-furlong pole and was uninvolved in the late stages. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START. AFTER A REVIEW NO ACTION WAS TAKEN. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

WHO DEY got away a bit slowly but pulled forward to join FAIR AND SQUARE passing the finish line for the first time, settled in a stalking position through the clubhouse turn, then moved to challenge that rival for the lead with a half-mile to run, traded blows from that point to the finish, exchanging bumps along the way, both horses and riders giving all, then got a favorable head bob at the wire to win a thriller. FAIR AND SQUARE drifted out some after the start, then took the lead past the finish line the first time, had WHO DEY stalking to the outside but was left to dictate the early fractions, met the challenge by the rival near the half-mile pole, then engaged that one in a ferocious battle through the turn and down the stretch, never wavered but got an unlucky head bob at the wire and lost a heartbreaker. SILENCE settled three-wide, was kept to task late, and outfinished the rest for the minor award. TANTRUM raced in mid-pack, dropped to last on the turn, then found a second wind in the stretch and managed to pass a couple of stragglers near the finish line. I WANNA WIN got away best but ceded the front to the top pair passing the finish line for the first time, settled three-wide, got to within three lengths going into the far turn, then was unable to keep up in the late stages. PRIVATE MOMENT came away a little awkwardly, went three wide through the first turn, settled at the back, moved up on the last turn, but was unable to improve and one beat one home.
