SACRED CONNECTION veered out at the start, causing a small chain reaction to the outside, lacked early speed and raced behind the field through the first half-mile while being ridden along the whole way, started to run on approaching the three-furlong pole, then bid five-wide late on the far turn and into the stretch and finished up well under steady handling to get up in the late stages. CANDYMONIUM hesitated at the break, then took up when losing the path, advanced steadily down the backstretch while being coaxed along, bid for the lead at the three-furlong pole, then opened up passing the quarter pole, set for home at the top of the stretch wtih a clear lead, was under strong handling and urging then could not hold off the winner in the final yards. SO FAR SO GOOD got bumped by MAGIC PALACE at the start, then settled just behind that one through the early stages, lost a little ground and got boxed in late on the backstretch run, then got some room and launched a bid with three furlongs to run, loomed a threat though under a stiff drive in upper stretch, but was outfinished in the final furlong. CEVICHE got away well, then settled along the rail with no interest in contesting the early pace, settled in the middle of the pack down the backstretch, then had to be ridden to keep pace on the far turn, then finished evenly with a mild late gain while never a serious threat. LUBU broke in towards the rail at the start, settled mid-pack, made a nice forward move three-wide from the three-furlong pole, but was outkicked in the stretch. MAGIC PALACE broke out and bumped SO FAR SO GOOD at the start, then made the front and was left to dictate the early fractions, led the field to the far turn, then gave way readily under pressure before the three-furlong pole, dropped out, and stopped in the stretch. LIAM'S LASS was forced out at the start by SACRED CONNECTION, moved up through the clubhouse turn to take a stalking position just to the outside of the pacesetter, took over the lead along with CANDYMONIUM midway through the turn, then could not sustain the bid in the stretch and tired. DIVINE FASHION got caught five-wide on the first turn, moved up through the first turn to press the lead down the backstretch, still racing wide, struggled to keep pace after passing the three-furlong pole, drifted wide on the last bend, and had nothing to offer in the stretch.

COOL COUPLE was under a ride from the start to get forward position, was driven three-wide at the top of the stretch to bid for the lead, had trouble with the lead change, but still finished strong under steady handling and held clear from a mild bid on the outside in the final yards. ASK ISAAC was the distant early trailer, then rallied in the stretch to gain the place. QUARANTINO settled near the back of the main pack through the early stages, bid four-wide into the stretch, loomed a threat but was outfinished in the final furlong. SAILINGTHEISLANDS hustled from the break, settled in a stalking position along the rail, was stuck behind horses late on the turn, finished with interest when clear in the stretch, but lacked the needed response to threaten. DAYTONA GOLD outpaced early, raced four to five wide throughout, then made mild gains late while never posing a serious threat. PRINSIPITO broke well, then was always close up through the early stages, dropped back on the turn, then lacked a finish. EILEEN'S DESPERADO was quickest from the gate and made the early pace, tried to fight back when NO AUTHORITY challenged near the half-mile pole, got the best of that rival in upper stretch, but tired from those efforts and faded late. BELLE BOTTOMS broke out at the start while being hustled to the front, made the front under pressure from DRILLS WILD BRAT, dueled that rival late on the turn and into the stretch, battled gamely but was outkicked in the final yards. KICHI KITSU broke well, settled close up off the pace, saved ground through the turn, then tipped out three-wide for the stretch run and finished well but could not get to the top two. BANANA PUDDING broke in and bumped MIDNIGHT WARRIOR, was outpaced initially, then advanced closer through the turn, finished with some interest under strong handling, but could not make up the needed ground. A KISS FOR KHOZAN shied from the inside rival at the start, then took a bump from BANANA PUDDING, was four-wide contesting the early pace, bid five-wide into the stretch, had some trouble changing leads, but was mildly gaining in the late stages. NOT TODAY pressed the early pace three-wide, was unable to kick on from the quarter pole, and finished evenly in the stretch. WIN HERBIE WIN dueled through the early stages with PLAYING FOR KEEPS, got the better of that one midway on the turn, then was beset by a host of other challengers approaching the quarter pole, turned back all at the top of the stretch, then went clear under steady urging and held sway to the finish. DON'T STOP broke well but settled off the early pace, became boxed in late on the turn, then responded when sent through an opening towards the inside turning into the stretch, was outkicked by the winner but finished well to maintain the margin and save the place. BOHEMIAN STYLE stumbled at the start, settled at the back early, made a five-wide sweep around the field on the turn, then finished well but was unable to get to the top pair while finishing clear of the next horse. MOMMA K'S BOY veered out at the start, settled mid-pack, then became boxed in through the turn, steadied in traffic in upper stretch, then switched to the outside but was too late to make up any ground. LUST FOR LIFE bobbled, then bumped lightly with WIN HERBIE WIN at the start, moved up to press the pace through the turn, then flattened out in upper stretch while lugging in. JUST LIKE RAMBO was last away the moved up to race inside early, steadied before the half-mile pole, dropped back a bit, then switched to the two path and bided time in traffic through the turn, was in-tight again approaching the furlong pole and steadied again, then was unable to regain momentum in the late stages. PLAYING FOR KEEPS hustled from the break and got a share of the lead with WIN HERBIE WIN, dueled that rival into the turn, then was overtaken passing the three-furlong pole, tried to keep pace into the stretch, but was outfinished. COASTERTOTHEMOON pressed the pace inside to the turn, then weakened passing the three-furlong pole and was uninvolved in the late stages. SUNSET TOWN got pinched back at the start, spotted the rest a bit of a head start, advanced four wide on the turn to loom about six-wide at the top of the stretch, but flattened out and was unable to threaten.
