MATTHEW'S PATRIOT broke well, then pressed GOTTOMAKEITHAPPEN through the initial stages while traveling well, took command midway on the turn and quickly put some distance on the rest, then responded when set down at the top of the stretch and drew off with authority. PECKS NOT BAD tracked three-wide up close down the backstretch, tried to keep pace chasing MATTHEW'S PATRIOT through the turn but was unable to go with that one in the stretch, kept on well late to hold the place. OVERLOAD was pushed on a bit from the start to get forward position, settled mid-pack to the turn, was under a ride leaving the three-furlong pole, then under steady urging in the stretch, could not find another gear when needed, but moved up into third. VENTURE ON raced at the back of the main pack, came into the stretch behind horses, then shifted to the outside and was mildly gaining in the late stages. SPEEDY MOBILE was under steady coaxing to keep pace early, then made a mild middle move through the turn racing in the three-path, then flattened out in the stretch. MISTER MOBIL was away awkwardly, then slow into stride, and did not appear to handle the going. GOTTOMAKEITHAPPEN was sent to the front after breaking a step slow, dueled through the early stages wih MATTHEW'S PATRIOT, then gave way before the three-furlong pole and faded to the back.

SHE'S SO SEXY dueled inside of LIAR FOR HIRE, then took command on the turn and drew away by a dozen lengths or more in the stretch. MISS SERAFINA broke well but was not fast enough to contest the early pace, dropped back before the turn, then came back on under a stiff ride, was kept to task under strong handling and steady urging just got up for the place. PEARL MAGIC was slow to begin, then put under a ride from the start, finished with some interest, and just missed second. LIL BREEZZY was off slowly, steadily advanced down the back stretch, then struggled to keep up on the turn and was unable to threaten. LIAR FOR HIRE briefly dueled outside of SHE'S SO SEXY to the turn, then gave way and tired in the stretch. MISS TECA got off to a level start but was unable to keep pace early, dropped to last, then chased the rest of the way.

INTERVAL pressed the early pace three-wide, bid for the lead at the quarter pole, lugged in under right-handed urging but managed to shake free late and prevailed. GAME MAKER (IRE) tracked behind the early pace to the stretch, then produced a grinding finish under steady urging to gain second. FIRST ACT got away well, pressed the pace two-deep to the turn, went to the front passing the seven-sixteenth pole with INTERVAL in pursuit, kept that rival at bay through the turn, but was outfinished in the stretch, weakened late, and was passed for the place in the final yards. PREDECESSOR was allowed to settle from the break and trailed early, was well behind the rest going into the turn, then launched a bid with three furlongs to run, took a three-to-four wide path into the stretch, had to check just inside the eighth pole when MAAM CROSS took the path, but re-bid in the final yards and was gaining ground. LEGENDARY STAR veered out at the start, was outrun through the early stages, then made a mild late bid but lacked the needed response. MARAVICH settled inside and lacked a rally. MAAM CROSS sprinted to the lead from the break, was overtaken by a pair of rivals to the outside, tried to come back on in the stretch, but drifted out under left-handed urging and tired.

SAINT GOAR dropped back after a level start, settled mid-pack to the turn, then moved up on the turn to bid three-wide for the lead at the top of the stretch, finished up well under steady handling, and went clear past the sixteenth marker. MIGHTY LES was outpaced early, then bid five-wide into the stretch, and put in a good rally to gain second. PAY ZONE dueled outside of YOU BET A FORTUNE from the start into upper stretch, then weakened in the final furlong and faded.

MUTINY broke best and went to the front, was soon surrounded by a host of challengers all wanting a piece of the lead, shook off most of the foes on the turn under a confident ride, carried a short lead into the stretch, responded when roused in upper stretch, and held sway under a steady hand ride to the finish. WILDCAT BILL was off a bit awkwardly, then rushed up to join the early pace scramble, got a head in front past the half-mile marker, quickly lost that lead to MUTINY, kept on well late, but could not get by the winner nor cut into the margin. OAKS HONEY settled at the back early, raced five-wide and was closing the margin in the final yards. MUCHO PRIMO broke well and was four-wide in the early pace battle, made a run at MUTINY on the lead late on the turn, but could not go on when that rival kicked away in mid-stretch. PARTY POOPER pressed the pace three-wide in a mad scramble for the early lead, dropped out before the turn, and went evenly late. SERENDIPITOUS chased from mid-pack along the rail, was under a ride midway through the turn, loomed in upper stretch but flattened out late. CRAFTED got pinched back at the start, steadied near the three-furlong pole, then tried to come back on in the stretch but lacked the necessary response. HARVARD stumbled at the start, n, pulled even near the five-furlong pole, then dueled outside of that rival through the far turn and into the stretch, gained a slight advantage in the final furlong and held clear to the finish under steady handling and intermittent urging. SMASH made the lead easily from the start, was joined by HARVARD at the five-furlong pole, went together with that one through moderate fractions to the far turn, then dug in when both riders set down approaching the quarter pole, then weakened in the final yards. OILER tracked three-wide from the outset, tried to maintain position when the pace quickened after the half, loomed a threat approaching the quarter pole while under a drive, but could not find the needed late kick, and managed to save third. PITTSBURGH was always four-to-five wide, went one-paced throughout. VINCENZINO settled at the back of the field along the rail through the early stages, advanced closer down the backstretch, but was unable to generate a late bid. FOOD FOODIE lacked any early speed, trailed early, and never threatened. FIREWATER JAKE settled near the rear through the first half-mile, went wide through the far turn and lacked a finish. FUN LOVIN CRIMINAL took a light bump from HARVARD at the start, then chased the early leaders through the first turn, then dropped back to last before the half-mile pole and was not involved in the later stages.

TRIKITRAKI hustled from the break, then was three-deep of a quartet contesting the early pace, waited to make a move on the turn, then responded when set down near the quarter pole, finished well under strong handling and intermittent urging, and edged clear in side the sixteenth pole. ILLINI rushed up inside to contest the early pace up the rail, held position through the turn, then was left with TRIKITRAKI on the outside, battled that rival gamely to deep stretch but was outfinished in the final yards. ZIPPIN GIGI was four-wide on the early pace, made a run at ILLINI at the quarter pole, was turned back, weakened, but managed to hold on to the third spot. SOLOMONS GOLD tracked behind the early pace battle, launched a bid at the five-sixteenths marker, came six-wide into the stretch, and flattened out. PANTHERA'S FATE chased wide through the early stages, then lacked a late kick. REAL NAUGHTY vied two-deep early, gave way near the five-sixteenths marker, stopped, and was eased to the finish line and walked off.
