SHADY NIGHTS settled off of the contested early pace, navigated traffic into the turn then mounted a rail bid to upper stretch, chased IDES OF DEMARCH to the furlong pole, shifted out and responded past mid-stretch, reeled in that rival into the final sixteenth, took command in deep stretch and held at the wire to prevail. CLEARLY INISH off slowly leaving the start and trailed in the early going, came under urging into the turn, rallied five wide to upper stretch, closed willingly into the final sixteenth, surged in the final strides and just missed for the win, while getting up in time for the place. IDES OF DEMARCH rated nicely off of the contested early pace, roused three to four wide into the turn, took command to upper stretch then drew clear into the final furlong, idled nearing the sixteenth-marker, was collared by the winner in deep stretch and just missed for second at the wire, while well clear of the rest for third. LADY ARTIST settled in the second flight early on, got to the rail approaching the turn and saved ground into the bend, chased from the inside to upper stretch and did not rally late. RUBY RIVER hard sent leaving the start, vied for the early lead and disputed the pace into the turn, vied between rivals heading to the quarter marker, was outkicked to upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. SMOOVE OVER was off slowly, recovered and chased the pace three wide to the turn, ran in pursuit four wide to upper stretch, could not find the needed late response and did not threaten in the final sixteenth. LATE FOR A DATE showed good speed away from the start and took early command, set a pressured pace to the turn, dueled inside of RUBY RIVER heading to the quarter pole, was overtaken to upper stretch and tired in the final furlong. FEISTY MAMA stumbled at the start then settled off of the contested early pace, raced widest along the backstretch, ran in pursuit five wide heading to the quarter pole, spun six wide to upper stretch, could not keep pace into the final furlong and gave way.
