## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

CUPIX settled off of the early pace while not far back, roused five wide into the turn, loomed at the quarter marker then vied for the lead to upper stretch, took command into the final furlong, kept to task into the final sixteenth and held safely over the oncoming runner-up. ASK ISAAC was unhurried in the early going and trailed into the turn, was roused at the quarter marker then angled five to six wide to upper stretch, made a sustained rally to the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and was a clear second. QUARANTINO settled off of the early pace while not far back, tracked between rivals heading to the turn, chased two to three wide to upper stretch, angled four to five wide leaving the three-sixteenths pole, was outkicked into deep stretch but churned on late and got up in time for the show honors. DAYTONA GOLD hustled in the early stages, went up and pressed the pace two wide and between rivals along the backstretch, kept close attendance to the pace nearing the quarter pole, battled into the stretch, weakened in the final furlong and was outfinished late for third. BOUND TO SUCCEED settled just off of the contested early pace, saved ground into the turn then was well placed nearing the quarter pole, split rivals into the stretch and advanced into the final furlong, could not sustain his run into the final sixteenth and gave way. STAROFTHEGAME was forwardly placed early on while outside of rivals, chased the pace four deep along the backstretch, ran in pursuit four wide into the turn, was outkicked into upper stretch then faded in the final sixteenth. INTERVAL chased the early pace from between rivals, went up and pressed three deep heading into the turn, lost position nearing the top of the stretch, could not find more into drive and tired. EILEEN'S DESPERADO showed good early speed and assumed command, set the pace up the backstretch then was pressured by a host of rivals into the turn, dug in at the quarter marker and led to upper stretch, was overtaken at the furlong pole and faltered in the late stages.
