DISTANT GALAXY was hustled from the gate after a bit of a tardy start, was the inside horse in the early pace scramble, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths marker, took a short lead into the stretch, edged slightly clear in mid-stretch, and held to the finish. GAME PERFORMER chased five-wide down the backstretch, then moved up through the turn, still racing wide, put in a steady rally in the stretch to get up for the place. TOP FROST took a bump from GO COLLECTOR at the start, but otherwise got away well, was three-deep in the thick of the early pace battle, got a head in front past the five-sixteenths marker, then was overtaken by DISTANT GALAXY in upper stretch and was outfinished. ABUNDANT ENERGY was off slow then hustled up to join the main pack, had no path going into the turn, bided time at the back but kept to the inside, put in a steady finish up the rail, but was unable to crack the top three. RUNNINGONHIGHLEVEL got away well, raced three-deep contesting the early pace, came under the crop near the quarter pole but did not respond and was not a factor in the late stages. STEPNOSKI was slow into stride but moved up to join the early pace battle, got boxed in through the turn, then lacked a finish. GO COLLECTOR broke outward and bumped TOP FROST, moved up and was the inside horse in the early pace battle, held position to the stretch, then weakened.
