TWERK got off to an awkward start, then settled five-wide behind the pace battle, moved up from the seven-sixteenths marker, circled the field on the turn to gain contention approaching the quarter pole, bid five-wide into the late, altered course to the outside just past the three-sixteenths marker, then put in a strong late rally under steady handling to be along in time. RUBY LAYNE rushed up to join the leaders after a bit of a tardy start, started to drop back after passing the three-furlong pole and was eased up to the finish, was later reported to have bled. DRILLS WILD BRAT got away in good order then ceded the front to PARLAY, was always close to that one to the far turn, moved up to challenge at the quarter pole with another rival bidding to the outside, floated a little wide into the stretch, then battled determinedly to the finish, got a head in front late and prevailed. COUNTESS COLETTE off slow and was far back through the early stages, started to run on heading into the far turn, then sustained the rally with a furious rally down the stretch, closed in approaching the finish, and just missed. PARLAY was roused from the start to get to the front, gained the early advantage on the clubhouse turn, then was left alone to dictate the early fractions with the field lined up behind, fought back when confronted by a pair of rivals at the quarter pole, battled gamely to deep stretch, but weakened in the closing yards. IMA MOM tucked in the two-path near the back of the main pack, was three-wide through the far turn, launched a bid leaving the three-furlong pole, finished up strong under a strong ride and steady urging, closed

stoutly but came up short. HOT PRINCESS settled mid-pack, got an inside run through the far turn, then loomed a threat under a strong right-handed crop but weakened in the final yards. KICHI KITSU ducked in at the start but was forwardly placed early, maintained a close up position three-wide to the far turn, bid for the lead under a drive approaching the quarter pole, but flattened out in the stretch. PRAISE N GLORY hustled from the break but was unable to challenge for the lead, raced inside in the middle of the field, saved ground throughout, ran on some late, but was never a serious threat. MOBIL CHIC settled well behind the main pack, ran on late to improve position. MIZ KEETA settled in the middle of the track but never fired. TIERNEY got caught four-wide on the first turn, then settled mid-pack on the outside, and was unable to muster a late bid. FEELING EASY raced at the back of the main pack to the far turn, then lacked a finish. COLORYOUREGGS was forwardly placed on the inside through the early stages, started to lose ground before the far turn, and stopped in the stretch. KETTLE KISS dropped far behind early and was pulled up on the backstretch, and walked off.

DON'T STOP ducked out at the start, taking the path from the outside rival, was briefly in front, then ceded the lead, remaining close up, chased into the stretch, then wore down that rival, gaining the advantage in deep stretch, and went clear in the final yards. BLAZING BURROUGHS hopped at the start, then rushed up to take the lead before the half, opened up on the turn, then gave way inside the sixteenth. LUST FOR LIFE veered in at the start, circled four-wide on the turn, had some trouble with the lead change in the stretch, lugged in, but finished well enough to gain third. JUST LIKE RAMBO was up close inside early, backed off near the three-furlong pole, and finished evenly in the stretch. STREETS OF WAR lost the path and took up at the start when bothered by DON'T STOP, raced at the back of the very compact field to the stretch, then was set down and tried to rally, lost the path and steadied near the sixteenth pole and was unable to recover. MAGICAL MONARCH raced four-wide close up to the turn, was unable to kick on with the rest approaching the stretch, and was not a factor in the late stages.
