MEXITEXAFORNIA broke on top but ceded the lead to PRACTICAL MAN, remained in a stalking position while always traveling well, responded when asked to go on passing the three-furlong pole, took command in upper stretch, and drew away under steady handling to win clear. MR LAOBAN settled mid-pack between horses, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole, slipped through an opening along the rail into the stretch, surged late, and finished on even terms with a rival for the place. GILLIGAN broke out and mutually bumped with the outside rival, raced close up three-wide just off the early pace, came four-wide into the stretch and closed well. PRACTICAL MAN veered out at the start, then hustled up to take the early lead, was under pressure from MEXITEXAFORNIA through the early stages, could not kick on with that rival in upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong, and missed out on the minor award. SOUTHERN SENSE broke in and bumped with GILLIGAN at the start, was five-wide throughout and lacked a rally. SILVER STYLE slow early, moved up the rail to race in mid-pack by the turn, then, was unable to keep pace and outrun through the late stages. MAXWELL ESQUIRE got shuffled back at the start, settled at the rear of the field and never rallied.
