ROCK THE RED ceded the early lead to CANAVARO while racing at the head of the main pack, was sent after that leader on the turn, caught up near the top of the stretch, met no resistance, took command past the three-sixteenths marker, and drew clear under steady handling. COOL COUPLE tracked four-wide mid-pack, raced three-wide, then rallied into second despite lugging in through the stretch. CACIQUE ABARRIO ducked out at the start, bumped, then rebounded into MR. AMERICAN, steadied, then dropped far behind early, then later rallied past tired foes to gain third. MR. AMERICAN took a light bump after the break, then settled well off the pace in the middle of the pack, launched a bid approaching the three-furlong pole, came under heavy urging in the stretch but did not respond. GREEWHIZ veered inward at the start, making contact with CACIQUE ABARRIO, settled three-wide mid-pack, came under a ride midway on the turn, finished evenly while never changing leads in the stretch. TAPAKENA broke outward at the start and steadied slightly to correct, then chased while under a ride from the start, but could not find the needed response in the late stages. CANAVERO sprinted clear to a big lead, then tired and gave way in upper stretch. A LA CARTE stumbled at the start and was off poorly, raced wide throughout and never threatened.
