SUPERWOLF broke in and bumped an inner foe, set the pace in the two path, waited confidently around the turn, was cued passing the quarter, and kicked on in the three path down the lane to hold sway. EMPIRE'S FIRE stalked in the three path, was roused midway around the turn, and ran on in the four path down the stretch for place. FORTISSIMO tracked in the two path, was coaxed along in the three path around the turn, angled out to the five path at the top of the lane, and kept on to get up for show late. BOOTS MALONE bumped with an outer foe at the start, rated inside, was ridden between foes in the two path around the turn, stayed on into the final furlong, but evened out around the sixteenth. STAGE NAME hopped then got bumped by an outer foe into an inner foe at the start, trailed in the theee path, was coaxed from the four path midway around the turn, angled out to the six path at the top of the stretch, but made no closing bid. HENRY MAC laid up close along the inside but yielded passing the quarter.
