GEEGEE'S STORY broke well and seized the early advantage as STYLE IN TIME pressed the issue from the outside, surrendered the lead late on the turn but kept on under steady handling to hold position, then came back on in the final yards to snatch the victory. STYLE IN TIME broke outward at the start, into the path of LADY GIULIANA, bumped that rival off stride, was still away well enough to press the pace two-wide, put a head in front past the five-sixteenths marker, maintained a short lead into the stretch, but was unable to finish the task and was caught by the game rival on the inside in the final yards. MARMARA tracked three-wide behind the early leaders, loomed a threat at the top of the stretch, was mildly gaining in the final furlong but ran out of time. LADY GIULIANA was bumped at the start by STYLE IN TIME, then was under a ride to keep pace, and was hard-pressed to maintain position in the late stages. KATE WINS raced at the back of the field down the backstretch, came under the crop past the quarter pole, but lacked much of a response and was unable to threaten. ROYAL ITCH lunged at the start and was slow to begin, was coaxed forward four-wide to regain contact with the rest, continued to race wide around the turn, and lacked a finish.
