FRACTURE pressed the pace two-deep to the turn, ramped up the pressure midway through the turn, battled between horses down the stretch, and got a head in front late to prevail. DOCS LEGEND lost the path and took up at the start, moved up steadily down the backstretch, to press the pace three-wide into the turn, battled gamely to the finish, but came up short in the end. SUZIE Q'S SISTER veered out at the start but made the early running down the backstretch, battled back when confronted by FRACTURE on the turn, then DOCS LEGEND near the quarter pole, but weakened in the final sixteenth. LOOKIN LIKE LUCKY raced close to the pace to the turn, then was outkicked in the late stages. CAESAREA steadied after the break, chased throughout, lacked a finish. SANTORINO dropped back to last after a level start, raced five-wide and was never a factor. BITOFJUSTICE raced with the pack to the turn, then was unable to keep up late. SUPER SMOOTH was off slow then rushed up towards the front, started to drop back after passing the half, and was uninvolved in the late stages.
