## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

BIG FACTS broke in a tangle then rushed up into the early pace mix, was sent up three-wide to bid for the lead into the stretch, gradually narrowed the margin on LADY FORTUNE on the lead, and got up in the final yards. LADY FORTUNE hustled to the lead after a slow start, cleared away from the field before the half, maintained the margin into the stretch, then started to weaken a bit in the final yards and was passed up for the win while holding clear to save the place. BOX STEP veered out into the path of BIG FACTS at the start, went to the lead but ceded the front before going a furlong, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, flattened out some late but managed to hold on for the minor award. TWERK saved ground, raced in mid-pack to the stretch, then

was kept to task late, finished with interest, and just missed getting into third. KAT TRAX settled at the back early, then ran on some in the stretch to improve. LADY LOTTIE tracked the pacesetter three-wide to the stretch, then tired. TRULY INCLUSIVE raced in the back half of the field early, was always five-wide, and was mildly gaining in the late stages. DANZA MAGIC off slow, lacked any speed from the outset, and chased throughout. POWER BANKER raced four-wide mid-pack and lacked a rally. CITY SIGNS raced inside with the group tracking the runaway leader, then faltered in the stretch. SWEET EMPIRE lagged near the rear and never threatened.
