ROYAL DRAGOON trailed in the two path, advanced into and around the far turn, rallied to bid inside of the leader in the final furlong and edged past late. FIREWATER JAKE tracked near the inside, moved between horses turning for home, bid in the four path and among foes in upper stretch, led in the final furlong, vied with an inner pair late but got outfinished and saved place. BOLDNESS pressed the leader from the three path, vied and forged an advantage around the far turn, dug in to resist outer challenges in upper stretch, got headed in the final furlong, fought on between rivals but got outfinished. DREAM KNIGHT tracked in the five path, ranged up rounding the far turn, bid in upper stretch but needed more. WILL E SUTTON broke a step slow, raced off of the pace three wide, chased in the five path into and around the far turn, shifted in through the stretch and lacked a bid. NOT YET CHARLIE raced forwardly in the three path and between horses, steadied around the first turn then failed to menace. RUNAWAY HARRY set the pace along the inside, got headed by an outer prompter turning for home and faded. GAMBOLING GHOST got antsy in the starting gate, then broke multiple lengths slow, raced off of the pace

two wide and between horses, then in the four to five path around the far turn and made little impact. SUPPLY CHAIN lacked speed in the five path, floated to the seven path into the lane and failed to factor. VERBIER bobbled subtly at the start, stalked in the four path, chased between horses around the far turn and weakened at the quarter pole. AULD LANGE SYNE settled well back along the inside, trailed in the three to five path while losing contact with the rest around the far turn and was outrun.
