RED HEAD KID showed the way in the two path, built a clear advantage at the five furlong pole, opened up a wide margin turning for home and widened under a drive. DERBY INCLUDED came out and bumped a foe at the start, stalked along the inside, chased the clearing leader around the far turn, proved no match for claiming place in the two path nearing the lane, then held sway on the rest. MISTER MOBIL transferred contact from an outer rival to an outer foe at the start, tracked two wide and between horses, yielded turning for home, yet surpassed tiring rivals to re-edge show in upper stretch then held that position late. OAKS HONEY raced at the rear along the inside, then in the six path around the far turn and improved position. GOLDSTRIKER raced off of the pace in the four to six path, chased in the five path around the far turn and tired. RAVEN MOON tracked in the five to four path, claimed place before chasing the clear leader around the far turn, then weakened between horses. WATCHOUTFORWEAVER was bumped between horses at teh start, raced off of the pace in the three path and between horses while coming under a brief hold around the first turn, moved out to the five path at the five furlong pole then was done early. HARTSTEIN bumped with an inner foe at the start, stalked in the three path and between horses then weakened at the half mile pole.
