SLIGOTIME tucked in behind BRIARCLIFF racing along the rail through the early stages, launched a bid for the lead leaving the three-furlong pole, responded when set down at the top of the stretch, and held that rival at bay through the lane, widening the margin in the final yards. BRIARCLIFF made the lead on the first turn under a hold, went clear by a little over a length down the backstretch, ceded the lead to SLIGOTIME approaching the five-sixteenths marker, tried to come back on in the stretch but could not get by that one while finishing well clear of the next horse. MARAVICH went three-wide into the clubhouse turn but got forward position with the tracking group, maintained a close position to the far turn, then lost some ground when the pace picked up, responded willingly when asked to go on, but was unable to close any ground on the top pair. LOOKIN LIKE LUCKY tracked behind the pacesetter two-wide, came under a ride midway through the turn, kept to task, but was unable to make up any ground in the late stages. BUSTIN' BOULDERS brought up the rear from the start, trailed far back through the early running, then swung six-wide into the stretch and managed to pass one before the wire. SANTORINO ducked in at the start, then settled at the back of the main pack, never far from the front, tipped out three wide for the stretch run but did not respond. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN. AFTER A BRIEF REVIEW, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
