CORMAN bobbled at the break but went quickly to the front, dueled with QUARANTINO initially, then joined by NO AUTHORITY through the turn, put both rivals away and led the field into the stretch, then held off a late challenge by J J VALENTIN in the final furlong to prevail. J J VALENTIN broke a bit awkwardly but steadily advanced into a better position down the backstretch, bid three-wide into the stretch, finished up strong with aim on CORMAN on the lead, was slowly closing the gap but came up a head short in the end in a solid effort. QUARANTINO broke well, dueled in the three-path to the outside of CORMAN to the turn, then weakened a bit in upper stretch, but kept on well to hold third, clear of the rest. FRAME UP raced in the middle of the pack and was mildly gaining in the late stages. EASTERN EXTENSION (IRE) gave an even effort, but never posed a serious threat. NO AUTHORITY broke awkwardly and was last away, rushed up to join the dueling leaders at the half, vied inside for a little more than a furlong, then backed out before the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. PAIGE PERFECT was always behind.
