SHAMU rated inside foes while not far back, crept closer then briefly waited to the inside of a rival leaving the three eighths, was guided four wide for a clear run into the lane, responded when set down and forged to command near mid stretch, eagerly widened from there and was kept alert to the wire. REDWHITEANDTACOS sped clear into the first turn, set the pace towards the inside, widened a bit around the final turn, wandered outward once engaged near leaving the three sixteenths, failed to contain the winner but kept on willingly to be clear of the rest. GRACIE DANCE , three wide between rivals stalking the early pace, shifted in around the final turn but came up empty. DREAMING OF AUDREY stalked two wide between horses, edged up some nearing the half, pursued outside the winner leaving the five sixteenths, shifted out five wide for the drive and faded. PRINCESSOFTHENORTH , off slowly, was used four wide into the first turn, lost ground four deep past the five eighths and gave way around the final turn. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction, and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
