MAXIMUM OFFER pressed the early leader from the outside, challenged between horses midway on the final turn, long stretch duel inside the runner up, proved narrowly best in a determined effort. EAGLE DANCE in the second flight early off the inside, moved closer after a half, challenged three wide midway on the second bend, extended duel, outkicked in the late going. TOUCH OF MAGIC off a step slow, void of speed for five furlongs, began to advance far turn, came three wide for the drive, and continued to advance and gain the show late. COLD CASE in the second group while between horses, asked along in the two path turning for home, lacked a serious closing response. SISSY SOX broke alertly, set the pace for six furlongs toward the inside, faltered when headed by the top two in the second turn. SMOKIN HOT STUFF broke alertly, lacked speed while racing four wide through the first turn, continued outside and was four wide again through the final bend, failed to muster a rally through the lane. GWEN TO WIN fell back after a quarter and was never a threat. SANGARETTE in traffic then steadied late in the first turn, was finished after a half, stopped through the lane.
