TITLED LADY never far back off the inside, challenged three wide late in the turn, quickly clear, extended that advantage through the lane while under a hand ride to win ridden out. WINDY BAY back off the early pace while outside, moved four wide for the run through the turn, up late for the place, no threat to the winner. LOVER GIRL behind the pace while in the two path, in some traffic into the turn, three wide for the drive, outkicked late for the second spot. BOW DRAW void of speed, three wide through the turn when still back, steered out widest for the drive, made a run down the middle of the strip to finish well while too late. EDISTRUDIS fell back to trail after the start, could still see them all late in the turn, angled out four wide into the lane and was also going well at the end. MERCY WARREN off a step slow, raced back and inside, improved into the lane then flattened out a bit in the final furlong. ST. ALBANS RAID evenly paced just off the rail into the turn, angled out five wide entering the stretch, lacked a closing response. LADY DREAMER dueled up front along the inside, gave way. FACTOR THAT alternated up front off the inside, gave way from between horses and inside the winner into the lane, continued to back up. AINTNOSHAKIN KID broke back, was never a factor. ALOHA BABY four out to five wide through the turn, tired through the lane. STELLAR LILY was finished before a half.
