LOVE IN LIGHTS (GB) balked at loading, broke with the field then came in early to bother a pair of rivals, four wide first turn, worked way to the inside through the second bend, determined for the place while not a match for the runner up, left the track via equine ambulance following the race. VINO VIDI VICI in tight and steadied into the first turn, recovered and moved three wide and into a forward position onto the backstretch, could do little with the winner through the stretch, outkicked late for the runner up

FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF VINO VIDI VICI AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE INTO THE FIRST TURN, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
