SHARP SWINGER with the pace from the start outside, vied into the turn three wide, angled in slightly when dueling into the stretch, edged clear past the furlong marker, held the runner up at bay while inside that one and under steady urging. BYE BYE MILES stalked the issue up the backstretch off the inside, remained within striking distance in hand three wide through the turn, crept a bit closer turning for home, set down, could not get by the winner, well clear of the others. PUTTING EAGLE with the pace while along the inside, dueled with the winner into the lane, could not match strides with that one nor contain the runner up through the lane, saved the show. TIP TOE JOE lacked speed outside, floated out four wide turning for home, went evenly through the lane. MCMUSIC broke back, raced behind the pace just off the inside, angled out three wide turning for home, lacked a closing kick. SIR GALLIVANT last away, lacked a serious closing response. COVERT LAW with the pace four a half while between horses, gave way turning into the stretch.

DELPHIA broke sharp, set the pace just off the inside, rated kindly in the run up the backstretch remaining toward the inside, maintained a daylight advantage through the lane under steady handling. RIOBELLA behind the pace while inside, continued to save ground second turn, came out a bit nearing the furlong marker while under pressure, could do little with the winner the final furlong, clearly second best. SUPER ENTICING in mid pack while off the inside, steered out four wide into the stretch,along for the show, no threat to the top pair. MISS TAPPY TONE chased the winner for six furlongs off the inside, had little for that one in the drive, bothered just slightly when the runner up moved out approaching midstretch when beginning to tire, continued to fade to the wire. TORTUGA ISLAND tracked the winner from the three path, came up empty when called on for the drive. JUST LIKE MAGIC off the early pace inside, fell back to trail after a half, continued to save ground through the second turn, cut the corner and improved position without posing a serious threat. COURTNEY FAY failed to menace while racing just off the inside. CLASS CODE lost footing at the break, four wide through most of the first turn, remained back. UNDECODED broke back, pulled while in traffic late in the first turn, moved out to race three to four wide final turn, did not threaten through

the stretch. SICILIAN GRANDMA in mid pack and outside, gave way while four wide through the second turn.

OKLAHOMA LOGIC broke well, dueled up front off the inside, disposed of the other speed turning for home, increased advantage while drifting a bit past the furlong marker, held the runner up at bay late being kept to pressure. MOON OVER CHOCTAW behind the leaders off the inside, came three wide out of the turn, angled inside of the drifting winner a sixteenth out and was getting to that one late, well clear of the others. BELVEDERE CLUB steadied slightly toward the inside just after the start, settled, went one paced through the lane to finish up best of the rest. TALENT CONNECTION moved up to duel inside, alternated for the lead into the turn, first to blink by late in the end, weakened. DEVIL'S DEN four wide into the stretch, failed to muster a rally. CHITTOZ'S BLUR last away, moved inside, saved ground turn, failed to threaten through the lane.

HEY EUGENE behind the leaders in the two path, steered or three wide when beginning to advance turning for home, ground on through upper stretch to reach a challenging position on the outside with a furlong to run, gained the advantage inside the furlong grounds, held the runner up safe late. DRIFTER back off the pace while toward the inside, two path into the lane, shifted to the far outside in deep stretch, finished willingly to close the gap on the winner while edging clear for the place. WORTH LOOKING broke back, lacked speed outside, four to five wide exiting the turn, was also going well late to earn the show. DERBY DATE last away, continued devoid of speed up the backstretch and into the turn, waited in some traffic late in the bend, got through, improved position. DANCE MAN broke alertly to be with the pace from the start, dueled into the turn, fell back off the other speed a bit by late in the turn, continued to vie with that one and the winner past the marker then faltered. SMOKIN' HOT set or forced the pace in the two path, garnered a slightly larger

advantage entering the stretch, also weakened the final furlong. CAPTAIN JACK lacked speed, in traffic three wide late turn, moved out four wide for the drive, did not fire. HUSKER BUTCH tired while racing four down to three wide through the turn. DICEY WAGER forwardly placed along the rail early, backed up through the turn and continued to fade down the lane. ARTHUR within striking distance for almost a half while outside, stopped.
