REMEMBER THE FEAR off a step slow, remained void of speed for a half, swung out to be five wide late in the turn when beginning to rally, closed with a rush while remaining out in the strip to nail the runner up at the wire. LORD DIAMOND closest to the leader three wide, went after that one entering the stretch, took over from the outside, led late, nailed by the winner in the final jumps, narrowly saved the place. CAT STORM in mid pack while racing off the inside, in some traffic entering stretch when bumped soundly with BIG WALK, quickly recovered and rallied willingly through traffic to just miss the place. ZOOM broke alertly, soon got clear, responded when the runner up came alongside upper stretch, dueled past the furlong marker with that rival and gave ground grudgingly to the wire. CHASIN' CHAFFIN forwardly placed along the inside, remained in contention past the furlong marker, lacked a winning punch

late. COAL STONE in the main body off the inside, four to five wide turning for home, went evenly through the lane. CHANCES TAKEN in the second flight while well out in the strip, four wide turn, had little left late. BIG WALK bothered, in tight early to be off slowly, raced back off the pace inside, moved off the rail in traffic exiting the turn, bumped soundly with CAT STORM entering the stretch, went evenly to the wire. WESTEROS behind the pace, dropped to the inside late in the turn, failed to muster a rally. PEA EYE broke out setting off a chain reaction of interference with outer rivals, lacked speed, four to five wide late in the bend, remained back. LOW ON FUNDS outbroke trouble, raced forward backstretch, in tight, steadied into the turn, faded. CASH APP MIKE jammed at the break, trailed throughout.

PRETTY LAYLA broke on top, cleared into the first turn, set a pressured pace into the far turn, shook off that foe while remaining just off the inside, clear past the furlong marker, held the runner up safe late under firm handling. CARARRA allowed the pace to go early, raced in the second flight final turn, got out a bit into the stretch, was righted behind the winner, angled to the outside of that one, roused firmly, slowly getting to that same rival late only to run out of real estate. PERFECT SHOT within striking distance off the inside, raced outside the runner up second turn, floated out a bit by that rival to be four wide for the drive, lacked a significant closing response to finish up best of the rest. STANDOUTSENSATION chased the winner early, closed the gap on that one up the backstretch, challenged on the outside late in the final bend, faltered in the drive. BETTE DAVIS lost footing at the start, trailed early as a result, improved a bit through the second turn, flattened out in the drive. CONTOUR remained always back while closest to the inside. MO SHIRO was finished after a half, trailed home.
