MO SENSE raced off the pace in the two path, improved while pushed along from the rail around the far turn, tipped out to the two passing the quarter, split the leading duo to bid from the three path at the top of the lane, took the lead while floating out to the five path passing the furlong grounds, and kicked away. CRUSHED ICE settled in midpack from the three path, ranged up under a drive passing the quarter, got floated out to the seven path in upper stretch, and ran on to edge out place late. ARGAN showed the way from the two path up the backstretch, came under a drive passing the three-eighths pole, faced an outer challenger while just off the rail midway around the far turn, fought on stubbornly while tipping out to the four path at the top of the lane, lost the lead entering the final furlong, then faded to show. MERCY WARREN bumped with an outer foe at the start, pressed the leader from the four path up the backstretch, vied under coaxing from the three path midway around the far turn, got carried out to the six path in upper stretch, then yielded in the final furlong. BEE A QUEEN tracked inside, tipped out to the two path entering the far turn, lost a couple spots while driven between foes approaching the quarter, swung from the five path into the lane, and weakened. WHAT'S TO DO hopped at the start, rated in the two path, improved under a drive along the inside around the far turn, stayed on in upper stretch, but came up empty in the final furlong. OLE SILVER chased in the five path up the backstretch,

merged into the two path while ridden into the far turn, but made no final bid. LEGALLY LUCKY bumped between foes at the start, trailed out in the five path and did not factor. MY BOSSY LADY chased in the four path but retreated around the far turn. WHAT'S CRACKIN bumped with an inner foe at the start, stalked in the two path but yielded around the far turn.

PUBLISHER tracked between foes in the three path, had to wait behind traffic early around the far turn, found room and was roused thru an opening approaching the quarter, made a sweeping move to bid boldly at the top of the lane, took command just after the three-sixteenths, and kicked away to be much the best. BON TEMPS set the pace along the inside up the backstretch, waited from just off the rail around the far turn before being asked for more run passing the quarter, got overtaken by the runaway winner at the top of the stretch, but kept on to clearly be second best. CRAZY DIAMOND hit the gate leaving, chased in the four path, rounded the far turn while driven in the three path, tipped out to the five path at the top of the lane, finished evenly, and just got up for the show bob. MINGO was prompted from up close in the two path, driven around the far turn, but faded from the four path down the stretch. FIGHT TIME stalked in the four path, rounded the far turn while coaxed along between rivals, but yielded from the six path down the lane. WOBBEONG rated inside, moved into contention while pushed along from the rail around the far turn, but weakened in the three path down the stretch. SAVING HEART floated out to the five path around the first turn, trailed from out in the center early, moved up passing the half, was ridden in the four path around the far turn, swung from the seven path into the lane, but retreated.

MORE MONEY MO tracked in the two path, was pushed along into the far turn, came under a drive midway around the far turn, ranged up to take aim while swing from the four path into the lane, kicked on to draw ahead of the inner pacesetter passing the furlong grounds, and safely held off an outer rival. REFINED DESIGN rated in the two path, moved up around the far turn, angled out under a ride midway around the far turn, swung from the five path into the stretch, and ran on for place. BRASS NUCKS drew away around the first turn to set a clear pace in the two path up the backstretch, waited while just off the rail around the far turn, was roused passing the quarter, floated out to the three path in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the eighth pole, then got overtaken by the runner-up around the sixteenth, but fought on to hold show. RAG TREE bumped with an inner foe at the start, was wellback in the three path, coaxed along around the far turn, swung between rivals into the lane, kept on, angled outside of the pacesetter around the sixteenth, but could not get up for minor rewards. JUTE BOX bumped with an outer foe at the start, settled towards the back of the pack in the five path, rounded the far turn while driven in the four path, and mildly gained but lacked the needed kick. AWOL got pinched back and had to check at the start, was well behind in the four path, made up ground while ridden in the three path around the far turn, fanned out to the seven path at the top of the lane, and improved. ROOTS TOOTN tracked in the three path, was coaxed along between foes in the two path around the turn, but faded. BACK NINE bumped on both sides and steadied at the start, trailed inside, cut the corner turning into the lane, but lacked a final bid. SURELY THE ONE bumped with an outer foe at the start, chased in the two path, angled out to the five path under a drive in upper stretch, but made no closing bid. MARITUDE was wellback in the five path, fanned out to the nine path at the top of the lane, but made no impact. MAZARN bumped with an inner foe at the start, raced off the pace in the four path but did not factor. INUIT bumped with an inner foe at the start, was hustled from midpack in the three path, driven in the two path around the turn, but weakened from the four path down the lane. MY SWEET ANGEL got fractious in the gate then had an awkward start, raced off the pace outside, merged to the three path entering the turn, but never threatened. BEST OF MAX chased out in the five path but retreated.
