WOODCOURT dueled early just off the inside, allowed the other speed to go just before a quarter, chased that one up the backstretch and through the final turn, went after the leader in upper stretch, took over, got clear and then held the runner up safe late. SIR GREYLIND off slowly, saved ground onto the backstretch, continued inside into the final turn, swung out widest for the drive, rallied down the middle of the strip to finished willingly while too late for the winner. AWESOME AARON dueled up front outside the winner first turn, cleared just before a quarter, showed the way into and through the final turn, offered little resistance to the winner when that one came calling again nearing midstretch, also proved no match for the runner up, comfortably save the show. GOLDEN GLIDER settled off the pace inside, continued to save ground through the second turn when with the main body, went evenly through the stretch in lacking a closing punch. ONTHESTAGE void of early foot, saved ground into the far turn, moved just off the inside then moved back to the rail to slip inside of a tiring rival, improved a bit while not posing a serious threat. YELLOW BRICK off a step slow, raced back just off the inside first turn, moved outside, four path through the second bend, lacked a closing punch. 

ROCKET SANDERS in the second flight off the inside, moved closer late in the turn in some traffic, tipped out three wide, bid, took over past the furlong marker, kicked clear under steady handling. CHEZ WHIZ back off the pace while out in the strip, angled out to be five wide entering the stretch, outside bid with a furlong to run, could not match strides with the winner the final furlong, clearly second best. SWEET FANTASY forwardly placed along the inside, bumped and was forced to check up with over a half mile to run, tracked inside turn, traffic, lacked clear room late in the turn, moved out a bit, up for the show, left with too much to do to try the top pair. WHERE'S RANDY broke back, trailed early, two path through the turn, lacked clear room from the eighth



pole until a sixteenth remained, improved when finally clear. RYNO WRECKER in mid pack while off the inside, in some traffic three wide turning for home, roused three wide midstretch, went evenly late. PARTYINTHESTREETS last away, raced back for a half, three wide turn, steered out widest in upper stretch, improved a bit with some belated interest. STATLER within striking distance off the inside, three wide through the turn, came up empty for the stretch run. SPOONMAN in the main group while three wide into the turn, dropped to the rail late in the bend, lacked room past the furlong marker and remained mired in traffic to the wire. CLEAR ECHO fell back to trail while four wide early turn, continued to trail into the stretch, passed tiring rivals. MR. COMMANDER pressed outside, three wide through the turn, tired through the stretch. WON NINETY was finished early while racing inside. CLASSIC CINEMA fractious in the gate, broke sharp, came in to bump SWEET FANTASY midway up the backstretch, gave way turning for home.
