PLINKO CHIP back off the early pace in the two path, steered out to be four wide when being asked late in the turn, engaged the leader from the outside past the furlong marker, long drive, fully extended to gain the nod at the wire. DOUBLEDADDY ISSUES broke in mid pack, moved up to a pressing position four wide into the turn, challenged the leader while angling in to the two path late turn, salted that rival away when straightened for home, hooked up with the winner soon after and dueled to the wire to narrowly miss in a good effort. TOODLE LOO broke on top, raced in the second flight inside, lost some position through the bend while continuing to save ground, moved out to the two path turning for home, was up for the show late while not a threat to the top two. CALL SADIE forwardly placed between foes, remained in contention into the stretch, chased the top two past the furlong marker, had little more and was outlikicked late for the show. PARIS ACCORD void of speed along the inside, saved ground through the turn, two path for the drive, improved inside of foes upper stretch then flattened out. ALOHA BABY back off the pace and the inside, was four wide through most of the turn, bettered position gradually through the lane while not a serious threat. MEMORY MAKER off a step slow, raced in some traffic early, five wide through the turn, failed to muster a rally in the

drive. MY SWEET ANGEL steadied in some traffic early, four wide out of the turn, failed to menace down the stretch. CLOSDATGATE void of speed in trailing early, passed some faltering rivals while never involved. POPS REWARD with the second group while between horses, checked up in tight early in the turn, fell back and failed to recover. AUNT DIXIE sprinted clear to show the way up the backstretch while angling in, continued to show the way turn, offered brief resistance to the runner up when that one challenged entering the stretch then gave way when headed. SPICY NOODLES remained always back
