HALLOWED HALL broke well to show the way in the two path, was nudged along around the turn, roused from the three path at the top of the lane, and drew away. MIGHTY NORA rated outside of rivals, angled into the two path early around the turn, then angled back out passing the quarter, floated out to the eight path in upper stretch, and rallied late for place. ARMY'S MARAUDER hopped at the start, tracked in the two path, cued midway around the turn, cut the corner at the top of the lane, and finished evenly for show. BLONDIE'SINCHARGE got a bit keen and steadied early, stalked in the four path, was cued passing the three-eighths pole, swung from the five path into the stretch, but flattened. NUTS AND BOLTS chased in the five path, lost ground in the four path around the turn, and made no closing bid. SISSY SOX prompted the pace in the three path, came under coaxing passing the three-eighths pole, but weakened down the lane. FRESH OUT had an awkward start, was hustled from in range along the rail but gave way in the stretch. DON'T THINK TWICE broke slowly and always trailed from around the four path.
