LEAR broke well, narrowly set the pace along the inside, continued to set a pressured pace into the far turn, found more turning for home to shake clear, maintained daylight to the wire under pressure. BIG GAIN stalked the pace off the inside, advanced and challenged three wide late in the final turn, fell back off the winner when straightened for home, slowly getting to that one late. ICE AGAIN in the second flight while between horses, continued in the two path into the stretch, mild rally to annex the show, not a threat to the top pair. POINT BLANK settled off the pace, continued in mid pack the middle half mile, angled four wide turning for home, not enough late for the show while also no threat to the top pair. CLASSICALLY pressed the pace outside the winner, vied between the top two into the lane, faded. FETCHS BRAHM back off the pace and the inside, four wide into the stretch, lacked a closing kick. ROYAL COURT steadied just after the start to trail early, continued to lack speed, improved position a bit in the drive while some modest interest, no real threat. OUTLAW RUN in the second flight three wide for six furlongs, steady retreat through the stretch. EAST FROM WEST tracked the lead pack along the

inside, had little left for the stretch run. NATIVE MOONSHINE remained always back while racing four wide.



GOLDEN EDGE broke on top, sprinted clear, give a bit of a breather while still in front by daylight through the turn, turned back the runner up with a furlong to run and edged clear again late. SENDING broke in mid pack, moved up steadily to chase the winner into the turn, closer still when lodging a bid from the outside approaching midstretch, could no match the winner late while holding sway for the place. MOENCHANTED back off the pace while racing outside, began a steady advance while four wide through the turn, closers to the top two with a furlong to run, slowly getting to the runner up late. L. A. DIAMOND went one paced throughout while saving ground. PATIENT EMILIE fell back to trail after the start, continued to lag turn, two path and between horses into the stretch, improved position in finding his best stride late. Y CITY broke back, in some traffic turning for home, improved position when clear while not a serious threat. WOODCUT bumped start, raced in the second flight while three wide and outside the runner up, weakened through the stretch. SUNDAE SPRINKLES saved ground to no avail. TACTICAL EXPRESS bumped at the start, settled in the two path, lacked response drive. SKY RAVEN in mid pack

while racing off the rail, had nothing for the drive. POLSKA SUE pinballed at the break, remained back. STEPHAN AGAIN failed to menace while four to five wide out of the turn.

DAZZLEMESILVER away in good order, set a pressured pace early along the inside, began a long, extended duel before a quarter, continued to alternate up front past the furlong marker, dug in late to find more and narrowly prevail in determined fashion. WITHOUT OBJECTION broke alertly, relinquished the

advantage to the winner soon after, pressed that one early from the outside, dueled, outfinished in the final strides while narrowly holding the place. I GOT NO MUNNY back off the pace and the inside, three wide through the turn when beginning to advance, ran on through the stretch and finished up willingly to be closing the gap on the top two. AMAZING SUCCESS behind the pace while racing outside, four wide through much of the turn, closest to the top pair a furlong out, could do little with that due in lacking a closing punch. ROWDY RASCAL broke with the leaders, raced forwardly and three wide, crept closer to the top two midway on the turn, stalled in the drive, lost a couple of positions through the stretch. HI YAH one paced early along the inside, in some traffic late in the turn when in the two path, continued in company nearing the furlong grounds, moved out a bit more, evenly in the late going. CANE CREEK ROAD behind the pace in the two path, came up empty when set down for the drive. HELLO HOT ROD shuffled back a bit soon after the start, four wide through the turn, worked his way to the rail by late in the bend, also lacked a significant closing response. BLOW TORCH raced in mid pack early while outside, three to four wide through the turn, ired. GAMBLER ROCKET remained back while racing outside. TRIKITRAKI finished early. RAVEN'S NEST fell back after the start, lagged, pulled up, left the track via equine ambulance.

GAME WARDEN vied early along the inside, fell back off the other speed and moved outside onto the backstretch, rebid four wide through the second turn, long drive, drifted in a bit to help tighten up a stalled SPEED BIAS in the late going, late push to prove best. BLACK POWDER forwardly placed along the inside, remained within striking distance into the far turn, boxed early in that bend, squeezed through a narrow opening into the stretch, challenged up the rail, outkicked by the winner in the late going while prevailing for the second spot. MASQUEPARADE settled off the early pace, closer while firmly in hand late backstretch, in some traffic far turn, idled past the furlong marker, took advantage of a large opening inside the leader turning into the stretch to challenge, came out slightly late playing a minor role in putting SPEED BIAS in tight quarters, not enough in the late going while between the top two at the wire. SPEED BIAS never far back off the inside, vied three wide second turn, narrowly showed the way into the stretch between calls, has stalled with less than a furlong remaining when in tight, steadied in the closing strides. MAGIC TAP within striking distance off the rail, four wide exiting the final turn, chased the lead pack past the furlong marker, lacked a closing punch. RED RUN fell back to trail after the start, continued to see them all through the final turn, did not menace through the stretch while picking off a couple of tiring rivals. WINNEMAC AVENUE off a step slow, raced back off the pace, four wide into the lane, failed to muster a rally. LAUGHING BOY narrowly set the pace just off the inside, gave way late in the final turn, continued to weaken to the wire. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF SPEED BIAS AGAINST BOTH GAME WARDEN AND MASQUEPARADE, IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THE INCIDENT IN DEEP STRETCH DID NOT AFFECT THE ORDER OF FINISH.

VERY COSMOPOLITAN dueled up front along the inside, fell back off the other speed turning for home, set down, found more, took back over, drew well clear. DEVLISH GAL broke in, bumped SHES A DEVIL WOMAN, quickly straightened, dueled up front in the two path, took over late in the turn, held a narrow advantage over the winner with a furlong to run, proved no match for that one in the late going, clearly second best. PRESLEYS TURN back off the pace and the inside, raced in the second group into the stretch while between horses, could do little with the top two the final furlong, held sway for the

show. HONDURAS PASSION in mid pack while off the inside, three path into the lane, continued in even fashion to the wire. THIS DAMSEL MAYFLY forwardly placed along the inside up the backstretch, remained in the second flight through the turn, had little left for the stretch run. PALMILLA'S BET void of speed, improved position inside of rivals into the stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. FLIRTIN AGAIN off a step slow, raced back, four wide turn, passed tiring rivals. SUBLIME HOPE raced back off the pace just off the inside, encountered some traffic late in the turn, came up empty when clear. LITTLE RAG DOLL tired after racing four wide through the turn. SYDNEY'S JOY off a step slow, remained always back. SHES A DEVIL WOMAN bumped at the start to be away slowly, moved up to mid pack then backed up steadily through the lane. PICKMEUPATMIDNIGHT broke sharp, headed up the second flight up the backstretch, stopped in the turn, trailed home.
