CAMP EVANS chased in the three path, angled to the rail while under a ride passing the three-eighths pole, tipped around a weakening rival just before the quarter, cut the corner at the top of the lane, kicked on up the inside to bid passing the furlong grounds, got put in tight by the outer leader in the final sixteenth, but forged ahead late. SEXAGENARIAN bumped between foes at the start, prompted the pace from the rail, was roused from the two path midway around the turn, bid while swinging from the three path into the lane, ran on to lead passing the furlong grounds, tipped in an attempt to fend off an inner rival, but got edged out in the closing stages. GO WEST GO dueled for the lead in the three path, drew away under coaxing around the turn, floated out to the five path in upper stretch, faded in the final furlong, but held show. GUN FIRE bumped with an outer foe at the start, tracked, was pushed along in the three path around the turn, swung out to the six path at the top of the stretch, but made no closing bid. MR. GOODTIME broke in and bumped an inner foe, trailed in the three path, continued under a drive in the two path around the turn, but made no impact. JUST KEEP LOOKING bumped between foes at the start, raced off the pace inside but did not threaten. SPEAKING LOUD vied for the lead in the two path but yielded along the rail around the turn.
