CARBONE forwardly placed just off the inside, remained closest to the leader into the turn, came three wide for the drive, collared that same rival with a furlong to run, edged clear. LINZER broke alertly, soon got clear inside, maintained a daylight advantage through the turn, drifted out a bit approaching midstretch, offered brief resistance to the winner with a furlong to run then could not match strides while saving the place. DANCIN FOR GOLD forward and four wide through the turn, remained in a forward position into upper stretch, lacked a closing punch to miss the second position. RAYMOND fell back to trail after the start well wide, five wide into the stretch, staged a mild rally to improve position. RIPPED forwardly placed while racing three wide, began to weaken late in the turn from between horses, some some additional position in upper stretch then went one paced the final furlong. NAVY SEAL raced back off the pace in the two path, passed a couple of tiring rivals while not a serious threat. TOUCHDOWN ARKANSAS remained back while remaining well out in the strip. CLASSIC TIME off a step slow, moved up up race in the second group inside, had nothing for the drive.
